

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

As the damage from the tornadoes has become clearer over the past few days, we realize that it was certainly more than just May-

field and Bowling Green that were really affected. We have had damage in Logan County, perhaps forty homes destroyed as I understand it, but as far as I know no loss of life. I was also surprised to find out how much was destroyed between Mayfield and Earlington. Fr. Jojy told me that five of his parishioners lost their homes, and perhaps eighty to a hundred other homes were lost in the Princeton community. Fr. David Kennedy, the pastor at Dawson Springs said that the roof of the church is off, and they are moving things into the parish hall. The rebuilding will take a long time, and I am glad that Bishop Medley has a charity in place to begin our part in that relief. And I am thankful for what you have already given to that fund. We will have envelopes if you did not have a chance and wish to make an offering. Pope Francis has given us a message of support, and it is good to know that in his pastoral care of the whole Church he also looks our way in our need. Please note the message that we have in the insert.

In this week's bulletin we also have a message from Bishop Medley regarding the Synod process and our upcoming participation in it. At the parish level we are to have two gatherings at some point around January and February with more details to come. In the meanwhile I invite you to read the message that he has given us and to make plans to participate when the dates are set.

Finally, please note our Christmas schedule. On Christmas Day in the evening the usual Saturday evening 5:00PM Mass will be moved to Sunday evening (the 26th) at 5:00PM since Saturday evening is still Christmas and is not yet the Feast of the Holy Family. That way we will have three Masses for the Sunday obligation.
