Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Merry Christmas! The Word became flesh, and made his dwelling among us. This is the great mystery that we celebrate on the Solemnity of Christmas, and the Sunday follow-

ing is always the Feast of the Holy Family. God chose to be among us not only as a member of the human family, but as a member of a particular family with Mary and Joseph. And so God the Son experienced family life during those years from his birth to his public ministry. The Scriptures are mostly silent on those years with a few special moments highlighted - the Presentation in the Temple, the flight to Egypt, the visit of the magi, and the finding of Jesus in the Temple. Jesus experienced some hardships in his early days with his birth in an unusual place, and his fleeing to another country at a young age. It shows us the paternal care of Joseph and the manner in which Jesus experienced what we experience. Displacement and suffering are realities for many people close to home these days with our recent tornadoes. At this time of extra difficulty for many in Western Kentucky including here in Logan County I am appreciative of your generosity in the offering through the diocese to the tornado relief. As a former pastor of St. Joseph I am conscious of the parish circumstances and needs. I know that they have a long way to go, and the support that we offer not only helps financially but also helps build up the fraternal bonds that we should have between one parish and the next.

This year, since Christmas continues through Saturday night (the 25<sup>th</sup>), the 5:00PM Vigil Mass for the Sunday of Holy Family is moved to Sunday evening (the 26<sup>th</sup>) at 5:00PM. With that adjustment for this weekend only we maintain an evening Mass for the Sunday obligation.
