Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

This upcoming week (the 17th through the 20th) the priests of the Diocese of Owensboro will have our annual convocation at St. Meinrad. I am presently scheduled to attend so **we will not be having any daily Masses until Friday, 21st**. However, given the circumstances of today, plans could change at any time. The following week, we will be having our parish synodal gathering. That is, on Tuesday the 25th you are invited to attend a prayer and listening session here at the parish. It will be followed by another gathering in February and a regional gathering after that. All of this becomes input for the Synod of Bishops about a year from now. The session begins with prayer to the Holy Spirit and reflection on the Word of God and then continues with a prayerful discernment of the Church. The usual measures for gatherings will be asked of all including wearing a mask and distance. Obviously this is a challenging way to gather, but it is the best we can do at the moment. And I ask your patience in this matter.

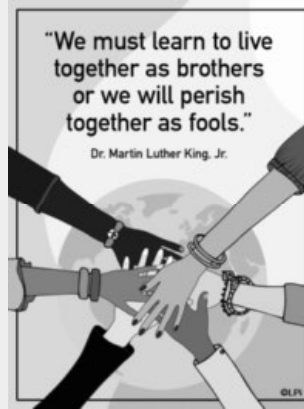

Pope Francis General Audience Wednesday Jan 12, 2022

Dear Brothers and Sisters: In our continuing catechesis on Saint Joseph, we now consider Joseph's life as a worker. The Gospels tell us that Joseph was employed as a carpenter of modest means, engaged in physically demanding work. Jesus himself would have learned much about the dignity of labour from Saint Joseph. Work is in fact essential for our human development and for our growth in holiness. Indeed, work is not simply a matter of material benefit or mere profit, but a means of giving sense, worth and shape to our lives, and teaching us to spend ourselves generously for others. Today, we can think of all those workers in our world who struggle to make a living or raise a family, and who often encounter injustice, exploitation and the threat of unemployment. Let us pray, through the intercession of Saint Joseph the Worker, for the protection of the fundamental rights of all workers, for an increased awareness of the worth of human labour, and for an economic order that will promote the dignity and prosperity of all peoples. Rather than simply a meeting of bishops, Pope Francis has asked us, the People of God, to take part in the synod—to "journey together" with our brothers and sisters in Christ along the path of renewal, guided by the Holy Spirit. The Holy Father has asked that every parish in the Diocese participate in this synod in order to listen to the living voice of the entire People of God.

Our parish will conduct a two-part synodal listening session on **January 25th and February 8th in the Parish Hall at 6:00pm** as part of the synod. These sessions will provide an opportunity for every member of our parish community to share our thoughts and feelings, but more importantly to discern how the Holy Spirit is guiding us in our journey together.
