Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

As it turns out the convocation of priests this past week was cancelled, and I understand that schools also have not been meeting in person. Looking toward this next week, it is difficult for me to say at

the time of writing this how prudent it will be to gather on Tuesday for our participation in the Synod. Hopefully I will have an announcement by the weekend Masses. One thing that would help is if you intend to attend, please call the office and leave a message in box 3 or send me an email. That way I can contact you if we cancel at the last minute. Similarly with religious education, please be attentive to messages from Melanie as we have found it impossible to gather on Wednesdays so far this month. In the meanwhile I will be checking with the diocese for any updates in protocols. When we do meet, since the circumstances and interactions are different from the Mass setting, I would ask each person to wear a mask.

One thing that stands out in our situation these days is the variety of perspectives. No matter where we fall on the scale of what acceptable risk is or what the proper sources of information are, it seems that each person has a certain evaluation of the situation and range of acceptable behavior and such. One thing we can do as a community is to be patient with one another amid the differences. Perhaps in some way we can help others carry certain burdens. Perhaps through attentive listening we can hear what values a person is holding and what concerns or fears agitate the person. Even if we come from a more informed perspective regarding technical matters, we are not more informed about the personal experience of the other that motivates his or her behavior. Charity is always called for.

### Pope Francis General Audience Wednesday Jan 19, 2022

Dear Brothers and Sisters: In our continuing catechesis on the figure of Saint Joseph, we now consider his example of fatherly love and its importance in the life of Jesus. In the Gospels, significantly, Jesus always appeals to the image of an earthly father when speaking of his heavenly Father and his love. We see this especially in the parable of the prodigal son (cf. *Lk* 15:11-32), which speaks not only of sin and forgiveness, but also of the love that renews and redeems broken relationships. Like the prodigal son, we too are invited to acknowledge our sins and failings, but also to let ourselves be changed by the loving embrace of the Lord. God's tender love is also seen in the trust he places in us to carry out his will by the power of his grace, which works even through our human weaknesses. As a loving Father, God helps us to see the truth about ourselves, in order to make us grow to spiritual maturity in Christ. That is why it is so important to encounter his merciful love in the sacraments, particularly the sacrament of Reconciliation. Through Saint Joseph's intercession, may we learn to follow Christ and to be witnesses to the transforming power of his divine love.
