

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

This past Tuesday a portion of our community gathered for the parish level participation in the synodal process.

It was a small gathering, but the sharing was fruitful. The aim is to listen to the Word of God, listen to the Holy Spirit, and listen to one another as we share hopes and concerns. The input received from Tuesday, along with the input from the next gathering on Tuesday, the 8<sup>th</sup> of February will be taken to the Diocese where eventually Bishop Medley will offer input for the Synod of Bishops later on. So if you would like to participate in the second gathering at the parish level you may certainly come on that day. Additionally, one could go directly to the Diocesan website to offer input, and there will be regional gatherings with Bishop Medley in March. Diocesan information is readily available here: https://owensborodiocese.org/synod/

Also, this Wednesday is the Presentation of the Lord, a special day for those in religious life, and a kind of conclusion to Christmas as it lands forty days after Christmas and commemorates Jesus who is the Light of the world going to Temple with Mary and Joseph. It is sometimes called Candlemas. For this reason we will have our daily Mass in the evening at 5:30pm that day instead of in the morning.
