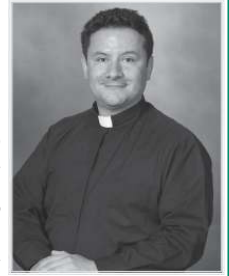

From the Desk of Father Jorge



October is the month of the Rosary! The Rosary is one of the best ways in which Catholics can pray. Why? Because **1. We learn our prayers** and we then can teach them to our children. When you pray the Rosary, you pray 6 prayers in one: The Creed, Our Father, Hail Mary, Glory Be, Fatima Prayer, and the Hail Holy Queen. Who says the current generation cannot learn their prayers? **2. An opportunity to build community.** When we teach it in the classroom or at home, or in church with others, we pray for our intentions and the intentions of others, so we get to know each other and our needs. **3. Teaches us, and our children, to be quiet.** We all have a hard time quieting down ourselves. We live in a noise-infested era. The Rosary helps slow down, be quiet, center ourselves, and focus on God. Repetitive prayer can help us concentrate more. **4. It teaches us about the Scriptures.** Remember, the Rosary is a contemplation of Jesus' life through the eyes of Mary. **5. It's a powerful weapon.** It breaks bad habits, vices, protects against evil and evil spirits, and keeps the Devil away (so pray a Rosary a day!).

FATIMA - This month of October we will also celebrate the 101st anniversary of the last Lady of Fatima apparition. Our Lady appeared to three little poor shepherds in Fatima, Portugal in the year 1917. She appeared to them during a period of six months, from May until October. What she told the shepherds was that we all, humanity, need to make reparation to God for He is much offended by our sins. She predicted the next world war and hinted that it was going to happen due to the sins of the world. Our Lady at Fatima asked us, through the little shepherds, to pray the Rosary EVERY DAY, for sinners who die and go to Hell because the have no one to pray for them. This leads us to a devotion we follow here at Holy Family, **FIRST SATURDAY.** Our Lady later appeared to Sister Lucia Dos Santos, one of the shepherds, who became a nun (the other two shepherds died as children and went to heaven). Our Lady promised that whoever goes to Confession, goes to Holy Communion, and recite and meditate the 15 mysteries of the Holy Rosary on five consecutive first Saturdays, will receive the help of the Church to die well. She wants us to offer that day, First Saturday, as a day of reparation for all the sins against the Immaculate Heart of Mary.

40 Days for Life - As you know, all life is sacred, from conception to natural death. That's the teaching of the Church Jesus founded, the Catholic Church. Our parish has one hour a week of peaceful prayer presence in front of Planned Parenthood, Thursdays from 11 am - 12 pm. If you can't make it to that hour go to 40daysforlife.com to check the calendar for other time slots available. This campaign is a 24/7 peaceful prayer protest to end the American Holocaust that has already killed 50 million Americans in 50 years.

Pet Blessing – There will be a blessing of pets out in the parking lot in Waterloo in honor of Saint Francis of Assisi at 2:30 pm on Friday, October 5th. All pets are welcome! Bring your own (no elephants, rhinos, hippos, or lions please. Giraffes are welcome).

First Friday Devotion – Friday, October 5th, is the first Friday of the month. At Holy Family we follow the First Friday Devotion. What is the First Friday Devotion? Our Lord promised to **Saint Margaret Mary Alacoque** in 1672, that Catholics who would **1. Receive Holy Communion** on nine consecutive first Fridays of the month (this assumes that the person is in a state of grace, having made a sacramental confession for any mortal sins prior from receiving Holy Communion) and **2. Having the intention, at least implicitly, of making reparation to the Sacred Heart of Jesus** for all the sinfulness and ingratitude of men, "they will not die in my disfavor [the grace of final repentance], or without having received the sacraments, since My Divine Heart will be their sure refuge in the last moments of their life." There is exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, Reconciliation, and Mass at both campuses to help people follow this devotion and fulfill the requisites that the Lord asks so as to receive His promises through this beautiful devotion. Please check the bulletin for schedules.

Confessions - During the month of October, Confessions with exposition of the Blessed Sacrament (The Lord sitting on the altar) will be in Waterloo from 6 pm - 8 pm.

Condolences - We offer our deepest condolences to the family of **Les Wakefield** of Marshall. Les died Monday, September 24th. He had a Mass and was laid to rest Friday September 28th. Eternal rest grant on to him, Oh Lord, and may perpetual light shine onto him. May he rest in peace and may his family find consolation at this time.

Offertory Program - Over the next few weeks, you will be hearing about the upcoming Increased Offertory Program at Holy Family Parish. This Program is very important as we move forward with the mission and vision of our Parish. We, as a parish family, have changed so many lives in our community as we have served God's people. In order to continue our mission and ministries, we encourage all parishioners to spend time in prayer and discussion with your family reflecting on the needs of the parish and your current giving level.
