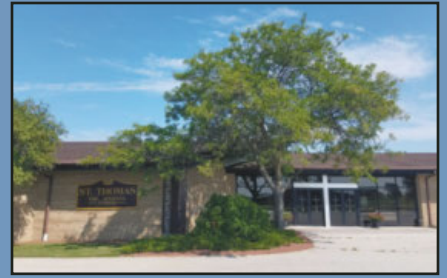

The Sacrament of Anointing

The Sacrament of Anointing in the past has been known by other names. A long, long time ago people were familiar with the term 'extreme unction'. More common was for people to ask for the Last Rites. Now we mostly say Anointing or Anointing of the Sick.

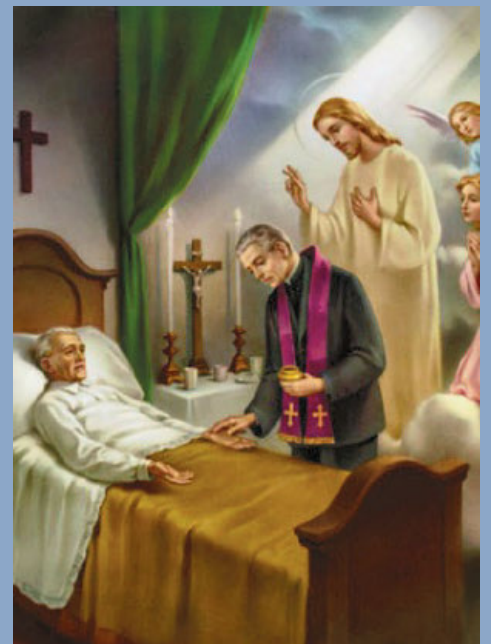
In the past it was only received when someone was near death. That isn't the case anymore and hasn't been for a long time. A person can be anointed multiple times. My Dad had a couple strokes and lived in assisted living for four years. I anointed him several times during those years.

So I would encourage you not to wait to ask for anointing for yourself or a family member until the last minute. It may not happen. I am happy to set up a time to anoint a person in their home, in assisted living, or after a daily or weekend Mass.

Here are some reasons a person may ask for the sacrament of anointing:

1. Near death
2. Old age such that dying could happen for various reasons
3. In the hospital for some serious illness
4. Facing serious surgery
5. Hard and debilitating mental/emotion issues, e.g. addiction, depression

I will also have Anointing Masses, one scheduled at each of the parishes in the next year. The first anointing Mass will be at St. Joseph Church on October 10 at 3:00pm. Anyone from our parishes or other may attend.

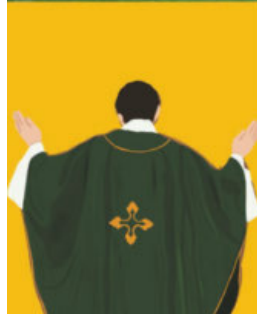
