

5th SUNDAY OF LENT

Who is without sin among you? When we are confronted with supposedly sinful people, we often think only of the evil thing they do. But have we ever wondered what their situation in life is, which may explain why they committed those wrongdoings?

The woman caught in adultery may have violated the rights of others or disturbed the peace of a family. But this does not give us license to do to her as the Jews want even if in the eyes of the Law, she is worthy of being stoned to death. Jesus' response is different. Instead of joining the band that wants the woman killed, he challenges them to examine themselves.

Are they also not guilty of sin? It may not be adultery but something else. As we can see at the end of the story, Jesus does not condone what the woman did, but gives her another chance and urges her to sin no more. And we can only guess the change about to happen in the life of the adulterous woman who is given another chance.

Do we sometimes usurp God's prerogative to judge? Why not give people the benefit of the doubt?
