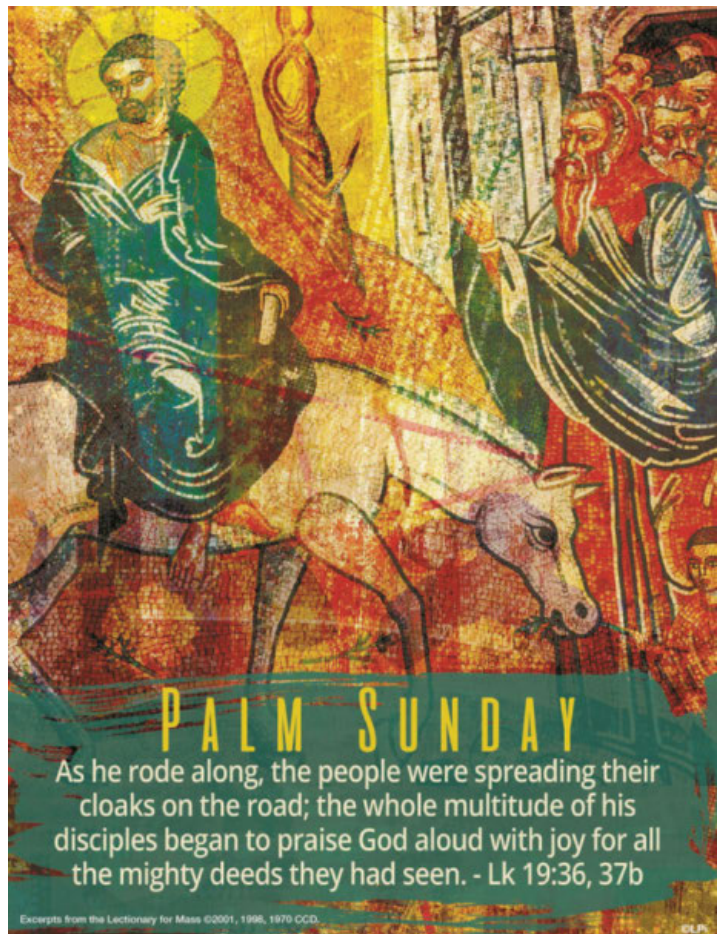
As missionary disciples, St. Louis Catholic Parish strives to be a joyful, vibrant, welcoming community, rich in faith and loving service to all.

THE EUCHARIST: THE GIFT OF LOVE

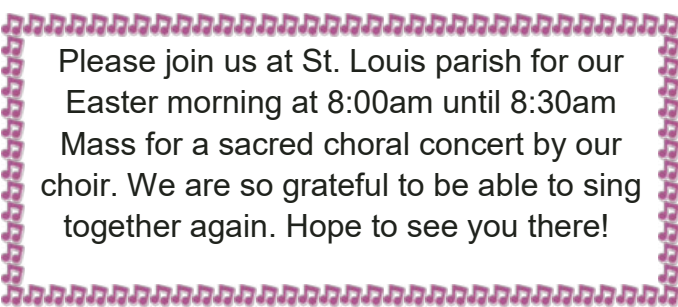
