

### WILL HE RISE AGAIN?

Between Good Friday and Easter Sunday many hearts and minds might have been wondering. Would Jesus' words come true that after three days he would rise again? His closest disciples, the faithful women, and, of course, his own mother, would have been impatiently but excitedly waiting for the confirmation of Jesus' words. Will he rise again?

The event in the early morning of the third day removes all doubts about the answer to the guestion: Will he rise again? The first person to have been so eager to find out, the first one to visit the tomb is Mary Magdalene. From the account itself, it seems she is resigned to find the dead body of Jesus – at the very least to continue expressing respect and "veneration" towards it even if it is as lifeless as she had seen it. And yet, as the account moves along, she discovers that she is too weak and wrong to expect to find the same lifeless body of her Lord. She should have been happier because she does not find him, but human as she is. she expects the "normal" course of events to continue - that not finding the body of Jesus, she thinks it was carried away.

But her anxiety and disappointment, perhaps, turns into the biggest surprise of her life when her Lord calls out her name, He whom she thinks is just the gardener. But, ironically, as one scholar said, she is right in thinking he is a gardener, for indeed Jesus is in a sense that: someone who cultivates hope and gives life. The resurrection of our Lord, then, to continue the garden metaphor, shows us that when we sow hope, let us cultivate it all the way, and not allow signs of "weltering" or "death" to discourage us.

I had a *hibiscus* flower which I thought had died because all signs were there of it being "dead": drying up of trunk and stem and falling off leaves. Only to be surprised one day to find new shoots emerging; it came to life again and is, as we say, "back with a vengeance" – full of healthy and fresh leaves. Again, to quote and translate an Italian proverb, "Hope is the last thing to extinquish."

Are we in a situation of seeming death, with all the signs accompanying? Even so, can we allow even a ray of hope to nurture the conviction that death is not yet, and that life has the last say?
