## GOSPEL MEDITATION

St. Oscar Romero said, “We cannot do everything, and there is a sense of liberation in realizing that. This enables us to do something and to do it very well. It may be incomplete, but it is the beginning, a step along the way, an opportunity for the Lord’s grace to enter and do the rest.”

There were a group of ladies many years ago who made quilts. They were beautiful creations reflecting inspirational designs artfully composed from the simple scraps of fabric each woman would bring to their individual pieces. There was no plan for the finished project as each finished work became the combined creation of what each woman contributed. They abounded in vibrant colors and dazzled the beholder with intricate patterns and their myriad textures. They were so beautiful that they became coveted family treasures passed from generation to generation. Those women never realized the power of their work. Countless babies rested in the comfort of those quilts warmly nestled in the legacy of tradition they were fortunate to inherit. They adorned countless homes with their beauty and brought joy and solace to many faces.

We cannot do everything. We are not meant to. Our work in life is to contribute our individual piece, a piece that reflects the unique thumbprint I claim as my own. We only have to do small things well. Then, as St. Oscar Romero reminds us, the Lord’s grace will enter and do the rest. We have to trust that this is true just as those women trusted in the eventual beauty of their final work.

Eucharistic blessings are blessings that start small and multiply. We all come to life with only a few loaves of bread and a few fish. Not any single one of us has all that it takes to transform our world. Who knows what God will do with the little we have and how many will benefit from our kindness, compassion, wisdom, courage, conviction, love, warmth, zeal, faith, and hope? That young lad never dreamed that his few leftovers would do all that they did. God shows up in unexpected ways! Where would life’s adventure and fun be if it were any other way? Being able to be part of bringing God’s creative, transforming, healing to the world opens us up to wonder, awe, and excitement! We can all bring our little piece to the bigger work of God that can result in being a coveted jewel passed generation to generation. This is good news indeed!



## FOR THE FAMILY

**Reflecting on the Word:** The multiplication of the loaves and fishes is the only miracle recorded in all four Gospel narratives. Today, it's hard sometimes to find miracles in everyday life because we often rationalize them or use science to explain them. But the miracle of the loaves and fishes must have been a story retold many times for all the evangelist to have a similar account of it. Often when we read the Gospel narratives, we learn that Jesus' followers were astonished or amazed. Can we, too, read this Gospel as the Good News, a genuine miracle, and be astonished and amazed at how Jesus took five loaves of bread and two fish and fed five thousand?

**On the Way Home from Mass:** If you were one of the 5,000 who had been fed by Jesus, how would you have felt?

**Living the Word:** Help your children understand the amount of 5,000. Gather various items from around the house in quantities of 100 each, for example, 100 cotton balls, 100 pieces of cereal, or 100 stickers. Try to gather 10 sets of those items to total 1,000. Lay everything out on a large table. Can you imagine Jesus feeding five times that many people with just five loaves and two fishes? What a miracle that must have been to witness!

## The Year of St. Joseph

One of the Church's most beloved saints is also one who we know relatively little about. St. Joseph is mentioned only briefly in the Gospels (primarily Matthew and Luke.) However, that story is one of faith and love for both God and the Holy Family, who were given to his care. St. Joseph lived a life of great humility as a carpenter. But most importantly, Joseph was a righteous man, which we see in his openness to God's will.

*Saint Joseph's life is a model for all men – a reminder of our own responsibility in society, in the Church, and especially in the home. The Catholic Church urges us to teach our children about the virtues of family life, through Joseph's example, whom God chose to care for his Son.*

We live in a time when many men have a crisis of confidence as to how they fit into today's society. The role of the male is down played - husbands and fathers who take their job seriously are sometimes humiliated as being old-fashioned. Some even blame society's ills on men in general. Sadly, it is true that too many men have neglected their God-given responsibilities. But, there are many more who want to be good husbands and fathers. If we are married, *then we have taken vows which are just as serious as the vows of a religious or a priest.*

We need all the help and encouragement we can get. Saint Joseph is the perfect patron saint for modern husbands and fathers. Saint Joseph reminds us of our responsibility to look after our children with compassion and concern. Religious artists often portray Joseph holding the child Jesus tenderly in his arms. This kind of love is not old fashioned. Hug your children as infants, toddlers, adolescents, and adults. Do not leave any doubt in their minds that you love them.

This year the Catholic Church marks the 150th anniversary of the declaration of St. Joseph as its patron. In observance of this anniversary, Pope Francis declared a year of St. Joseph to run from Dec. 8, 2020, through Dec. 8, 2021. Throughout the year, plenary indulgences are granted through prayer and penance; and through acts of justice, charity and piety dedicated to St Joseph.


The conditions for receiving an indulgence are a spirit detached from sin, receiving sacramental confession as soon as possible, receiving Communion as soon as possible, and praying for the Holy Father's intentions. *Below is a summary of the ways you can receive the special indulgences granted by the Holy See for the Year of St. Joseph:*

- Meditate for at least 30 minutes on the Our Father
- Participate in a spiritual retreat of at least one day that includes a meditation on Saint Joseph
- Perform a corporal or spiritual work of mercy
- Recite the Holy Rosary in families (husband and wife or engaged couples)
- Entrust their work daily to the protection of Saint Joseph
- Pray the litany of Saint Joseph
- Pray any lawfully approved prayer or act of piety in honor of Saint Joseph

Saint Joseph is a powerful prayer partner. He will help us with the difficult task of being a modern husband and father. Asking for Saint Joseph's intercession will often help us see our way through problems. Here is a prayer you might try:

***Blessed Joseph, husband of Mary,  
be with us this day.  
You protected and cherished the Virgin;  
loving the Child Jesus as your Son,  
you rescued Him from the danger of death.  
Guardian of the Holy Family,  
be with us in our trials.  
May your prayers obtain for us  
the strength to wrestle with the powers of corruption  
so that in life we may grow in holiness  
and in death, rejoice in the crown of victory.***
