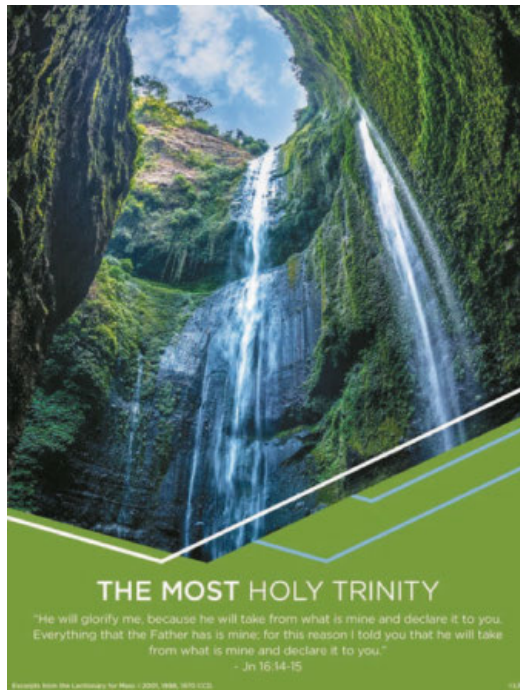

**DIOCESAN YEAR OF EUCHARISTIC REVIVAL TO
BEGIN WITH JUNE 19 MASS, OUTDOOR
PROCESSION AND BENEDICTION.**

Our parish will be joining with other Belleville diocesan parishes for a three year Eucharistic revival on Corpus Christi Sunday, June 19. When the Church speaks of the "Real Presence" she means "The whole Christ is truly present, body, blood, soul and divinity, under the appearance of bread and wine-the glorified Christ who rose from the dead after dying for our sins" excerpt from *The Real Presence of Jesus Christ is the Sacrament of the Eucharist. USCCB, 2020*. Our Bishop McGovern, along with other bishops believe that God wants to see a movement of Catholics across the United States, healed, converted, formed, and unified by an encounter with Jesus in the Eucharist-and sent out in mission "for the life of the world." These three years will culminate in the first National Eucharistic Congress in the United States in almost 50 years. Almost 100,000 Catholics will join together for a once-in-a-lifetime pilgrimage toward the "source and summit of our Catholic Faith." The hope is that through the three year Eucharistic Revival there will be a ripple effect that lukewarm Catholics will become on fire and fervent Catholics will become even stronger disciples. – this excerpt taken from *The Messenger* (May 26, 2022) page 2.
