Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi) – 19 June 2022

Genesis 14:18-20. Psalm 110:1, 2, 3, 4. 1 Corinthians 11:23-26. Sequence – Lauda Sion / Laud, O Zion. Luke 9:11b-17.
About Dining in the Kingdom of God. Luke's gospel is filled with meal stories. Most of them point to the Eucharistic Meal, as does the one today. Four verbs stand out: take, bless, break, give. This is eucharistic language repeated at every Mass. It is Jesus who truly took and blessed his Body and Blood – broke it and poured it out for each and for all of us – and gives to us to eat and drink – so that we may be like him and act like him.

WHY DO CATHOLICS HAVE EUCHARISTIC PROCESSION?

Eucharistic processions trace their origins to the Middle Ages, especially after the establishment of the feast of Corpus Christi in the 13th century A.D. The feast of Corpus Christi originated at Liege in 1246 A.D. and was extended throughout the church in the West (the Latin rite) by Pope Urban IV in 1264 A.D. It is a feast which commemorates the institution of the Holy Eucharist (Matt 26:26-28). As the feast (officially called a solemnity) became widely accepted throughout the Roman Church, Christian faithful came to make public Eucharistic processions, normally after a Mass and along a major route through a town or city. From this beginning, the processions became increasingly splendid parades and even pageants. In some cities, there were also mystery plays performed at the end of the processions. The council of Trent recommended Eucharistic procession as a public profession of faith in the REAL PRESENCE. The Church in the public Eucharist procession celebrates her joy in Adoration of Christ her Lord who is present body, soul and divinity in the Eucharist.
