# Campus Enhancement Plan...

In September of 2014, our Pastoral Council formed a Facilities & Propety Task Force with the mandate to propose opportunities for future use/sale/development of our present facilities & property..." This task force was able to sell the Main Street property and buildings in 2015 for \$1.65 million. After that, the task force eventually became dormant until 2020. In 2021, at the recommendation of the revitalized F & P Task Force, & with the approval of the Finance Council and Pastoral Council, we repurchased the 15 acres from the Diocese of Belleville for \$300,000, which they had purchased from us in 2004 at that same cost, which we need for our campus enhancement plan.

Since the completion of the Catholic Education & Activities Center in 2018, the focus of our Task Force has been athletic fields (including a Zach Epplin soccer field) for ICS. But we would also like to make some additional campus enhancements, including but not limited to a digital display sign at Quarry Rd; a large pavilion with restrooms that could be used for our Labor Day picnic & other events & activities; additional parking for Labor Day picnic & athletic field events; outdoor Stations of the Cross using the stations from the former church on Main; outdoor walking Rosary garden; greenhouses and garden for the school; Guardian Angel Legacy Society recognition space; a walking trail/cross country course in memory of Fr. Gary Hogan; & a refreshment stand for athletic fields.

We have some very preliminary cost estimates for this plan, and hope to get a site plan from a civil engineer shortly. Of course, we will have to get approval from our Finance Council, Pastoral Council and the Diocese of Belleville before moving ahead. Since we estimate that we will have about a \$3 million debt on the CEAC after the 7<sup>th</sup> year of our campaign at the end of 2023 (we're ahead of schedule on our loan payments), instead of launching just a debt reduction campaign, the Task Force is recommending that the campaign also include the cost of these campus enhancements.

I'm well aware that many of you have "campaign fatigue" from making campaign pledges and payments since 2006 (me too!), but I also think we don't want to lose our momentum on completing our new parish campus. Even though I'm retiring in July, I hope to remain in the Columbia area and will certainly be willing support this proposed project and campaign. We've accomplished some amazing things with God's amazing grace and you're amazing generosity, and I continue to be optimistic, confident that "whether we think we can or we think we can't, we'll be right!" Once again, let us work as if everything depends upon us, and pray as if everything depends upon God.

# Fr. Carl's Little Reservoir

This past Tuesday I attended the quarterly Metro-East Vicariate meeting, which includes all the parishes in St. Clair and Monroe County. At the conclusion of the meeting one of the Oblate of Mary Immaculate priests present mentioned that the Oblates have 31 priests serving in Ukraine, including two Bishops. Certainly we're all praying for peace there and throughout the world, but just being reminded that there are so many of our Catholic clergy and faithful there makes the situation all the more personal.

Recently the President of Ukraine made a plea for all nations of the world to show their support for his war-torn country, and of course, we all want to do something, but other than prayers we feel so helpless. Some cities and individuals have lighted up their

buildings or homes with the Ukranian flag colors of blue and vellow. You can also make a financial contribution through the Catholic Relief Services website. Recently I read that the national flower of Ukraine is the Sunflower, and so if you see a large sunflower at church this weekend, you now know why it's there. Also, in the bulletin this week at the bottom right of the next page, you will find a copy of a special prayer for the people of Ukraine, which I encourage you to pray frequently.

Finally, when you have to pay \$5.00 or more for a gallon of gas, remember the folks in Ukraine who are under siege and hiding in bomb shelters, and be grateful that the high price of gas is your biggest worry!

# The Season Of Lent Lenten Regulations...

Everyone 14 years of







age or over is bound to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday & Good Friday, and all Fridays in Lent. Everyone 18 years of age and under 59 years of age is also bound to fast on Ash Wednesday & Good Friday. On these two days of fast and abstinence, only one full meatless meal is allowed. The other meatless meals, sufficient to maintain strength may be taken according to ones needs, but altogether they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted on these two days, but liquids, including milk and fruit juices are allowed. When health and ability to work would be seriously affected, the obligation of the law is modified. Because Lent is a special season for all Christians, we should not lightly excuse ourselves from these penitential practices. To

# Discipleship Corner...

Last Sunday I had the honor to usher at the Rite of Election and the Call To Continuing Conversion service at our Cathedral in Belleville with other members of the Diocesan CCW. As Bishop McGovern addressed the Candidates and Catechumens in private, the rest of us enjoyed a presentation about the cathedral. During this Lenten season as we work to walk more closely with Jesus, consider what you can do to help a fellow crew member. Remember, we are "All in the same boat" on our voyage to salvation.


