Memorial Service For Mothers, Fathers And Veterans

May and June are months when families gather to celebrate not only graduations and weddings but the smaller more intimate familial events of Mother's and Father's Day and the summer's first real barbecue on Memorial Day weekend. Through a large slice of our lives these are anchors that we treasure since they both ground us and give us great joy, happy memories and occasionally embarrassing photographs.

But often as we age these same occasions can make us melancholy. We miss our parents when they are no longer with us, instead of buying hanging baskets of flowers we buy memorial wreaths. If we do not become parents, we can miss out on the joyful circle of life transition.

Our focus on Memorial Day often changes for the better in that we pay more observance to the real purpose of the holiday in remembering those that "gave their last full measure of devotion" starting with the Civil War so we can have our freedoms. There are still so many to honor, too many young people are still paying with their lives.

Fr. Carl's Little Reservoir...

He was a man with a little body but a big heart! Fr. Elmar Mauer, OMI, died this past Tuesday at the age of 88. He was born in Germany in 1934, and lost his mother in World War II. His mother's brother was an Oblate of Mary Immaculate missionary in America, and after starting tailor school in Germany, Fr. Elmar felt called to the priesthood. His uncle arranged for him to come to the United States at the age of 19, and after arriving at Ellis Island, he took a train to St. Louis. He entered St. Henry's Seminary in 1954 and was ordained to the priesthood in 1964. His first assignment was as a missionary in the Philippines. Then he returned to this area, and became involved in youth ministry, hospital ministry and retreats. He was also available to help parishes out when they needed a substitute priest for weekend Masses.

Fr. Elmar and I were both involved in the TEC (Teens Encounter Christ) retreats back in the days when I was the Diocesan CYO Director from 1975 - 83. He always wore red socks, and had a big smile for everyone. He was a special gift to many people here in our Diocese, and will be missed by all who knew him. May God reward him for his joyful spirit and enthusiastic service as a priest for nearly 58 years, most of it here in the Diocese of Belleville. $\sim Fr. Carl$
