Fr. Carl's Little Reservoir...

It was 20 years ago today that my pastor and mentor, Msgr. John ("Jack") E. Stallings died at the age of 84. It was in my 8th grade year that he came to visit me at our home in Shawneetown, and invited me to go to St. Henry's Seminary with the words, "I think you'd make a good priest." No more significant words have ever been spoken to me. Twelve years later, on September 15 (Fr. Stallings' birthday), I was ordained a priest at my home parish of St. Mary's in Shawneetown by Bishop Albert Zuroweste, the same Bishop who had ordained Fr. Stallings in 1950.

Throughout my years in the seminary Fr. Stalling was very supportive of me, always making sure I had a summer job and always inviting me to participate in parish activities, including CYO. In his later years, Fr. Stallings began a bulletin insert he called "Fr. Jack's Reservoir," which of course is where I got the idea for this weekly column. You should not be surprised to know that Fr. Stallings too retired from full time parish ministry when he was 75! ~Fr. Carl


