### ++From the Desk of Father Mike ++

It's difficult to recognize some things even when they are right in front of you. If you have ever mislaid your car keys and spent the whole day searching every nook and cranny, you know the frustration. When you find them right next to the milk in the fridge, you know the exasperation! How could you have missed them! They were right there all the time.

Jesus was in plain view all the time as well. Yet, His hometown folks only recognized Him as "the Son of Joseph the carpenter," not the Messiah. They only saw Him as one of them. How could He be anything else?

The Jewish people had been waiting for the Messiah for centuries. Their expectation was that the Messiah would look and act a certain way. The folks of Nazareth couldn't accept that Jesus, the Messiah, was right there in plain view.

Jesus brought with Him the keys to the Kingdom of God, yet His own disciples had trouble recognizing Him. It was not until the final weeks of Jesus' three-year ministry that Peter finally understood. He declared, "You are the Messiah!" In that moment, Jesus gave Peter the keys to the Kingdom. In more than two centuries they have never been mislaid.
