### **BISHOP POWERS DECREE ON NON-CHURCH CATHOLIC MARRIAGES**

Priests and deacons receive requests from couples wanting to celebrate a Catholic wedding in a location other than a church. The following norms apply to all proposed locations:

- The location should be in keeping with the sacred nature of marriage.
- It should be a physically meaningful place for the couple and provide a sense of the sacredness of the occasion.
- The wedding location may not be a bar, restaurant, casino, boat, on the water or similar location.

Being able to provide non-church weddings to Catholics is a promotion of evangelization, especially of the young. The church wants to welcome couples preparing for marriage, and have them celebrate a church-approved wedding.

Catholic weddings not in a church building would not in any way diminish the quantity or quality of our marriage preparation programs; all required marriage preparation must be completed regardless of the site of the wedding.

A priest or deacon would have the right to decline any wedding with which he does not feel comfortable. The priest or deacon, not the couple, is the one who will apply for permission.

These wedding ceremonies will not include celebrations of the Eucharist or Communion services.
