

The Liturgy of the Hours, the Divine Office, is the daily prayer of the Church, which marks the hours of each day sanctifying them in prayer. Priests, deacons, and all religious are required to pray Morning and Evening prayer, but it is not for them alone to pray. All the faithful are able to pray the Liturgy of the Hours. The Liturgy of the Hours is primarily praying the psalms, with a short reading from Scripture.

We will be praying Evening Prayer together for the five Thursdays of Lent: *March 10, 17, 24, 31 and April* <u>7</u>. This will be at 6:30pm in church and once again will be open for you come and pray in church or if you are more comfortable, to join us as we will live-stream this prayer as well.

Meet your Church neighbor......Ken Lasecki

As I entered his house to do this interview, there is a sign over his table. It read, "FAITH, FAMILY, FARMING".

When I sat to talk with Ken, I noticed he had another beautiful picture of the Last Supper. What led me to his doorstep, 3 things I think of after knowing him for many years: *POSITIVE OUTLOOK* --*ALWAYS SMILING----HARD WORKING*.



Ken grew up on a family farm in Pulaski. His mom was told at birth he had polio and his right arm was weak and small. When he was 5 yrs. old, a physician told him it was a complication of birth. He had surgery to help with the mobility and strength. He never complains and you would never know!

I remember him when I was a nurse and he was in Intensive Care where I worked. In 1982 he had worked a day shift at Fort Howard Paper and then went to help on the family farm milking and evening chores. He worked late into the night, chopping corn, when he became entangled in a machine and ended up having his leg amputated. "There was no rehab in those days," Ken says, "and I just had to learn to walk again! I had to do it!" Again, looking at him walk you would not know.

At that time he was a member of St. Benedict Church, "Father Leo Lessard and Jesus got me through this tough time. Disability was not in my vocabulary." He remembers being involved in the RENEW discussion groups offered in peoples' homes, which really helped him.

In the year 2000 his home burnt down, and no one was hurt, but he had to start over. Again, never complaining.

He became a member of Ss. Edward & Isidore in 2000, getting involved in ushering and helping at church picnics. The support of family, friends, and neighbors has been so important to Ken. He did get divorced along the way, but again moves forward. His hobbies are babysitting, camping and gardening, but he is never home and always busy. He continues to Valet at St. Mary's Hospital. He donates plasma regularly.

Ken has 4 children and 10 grandkids. "They keep me busy and they care for me too!"

I could see he was truly a faith-filled man, which inspired me to write about him.




