

Updates from the American Red Cross:

The Red Cross will resume testing all blood donations for COVID-19 antibodies on March 7. Plasma from donations that meet FDA's criteria for convalescent plasma may be used to treat immunocompromised patients battling COVID-19.



- In addition to helping meet the regular transfusion need of patients, the Red Cross is once again adapting its operations to meet the needs of immunocompromised patients battling COVID-19.
- In recent months as COVID-19 has surged to new heights -- overwhelming hospitals with critically ill patients battling the virus -- hospitals began to seek out more treatments for some of their most vulnerable patients.

SOCIAL CONCERNS-POVERTY

Pope Francis challenges us to live in solidarity with the those currently experiencing poverty. As Catholics, it is our duty to understand poverty on a deeper level so that we may address its root causes and lift those experiencing crisis so they may thrive and lead dignified lives.

More than 1.5 million children experience homelessness in a year. More than 37 million Americans live in poverty. Jesus taught us about embracing and walking alongside people experiencing poverty. About treating them as our brothers and sisters, not as outsiders. About understanding the systems that led them to become marginalized and keep them in poverty, rather than placing blame on them for their situation.

Pope Francis reminds us that it is through Jesus's example that we are called to encounter and build relationships with the poor, "The poor are not people 'outside' our communities, but brothers and sisters whose sufferings we should share, in an effort to alleviate their difficulties and marginalization, restore their lost dignity, and ensure their necessary social inclusion" (Fifth World Day of the Poor Statement).

Jesus not only sides with the poor; He also *shares their lot*. "The poor you will always have with you" (*Mk* 14:7). Jesus spoke these words at a meal in Bethany, in the home of a leper, a few days before Passover. Jesus was reminding them that He is the first of the poor, the poorest of the poor, because He represents all of them.

Jesus was concerned for and close to people experiencing poverty. In everything, Jesus teaches that poverty is not the result of fate, but a concrete sign pointing to His presence among us. We do not find Him when and where we want, but see Him in the lives of the poor, in their sufferings and needs, in the often inhuman conditions in which they are forced to live. The poor are true evangelizers, for they were the first to be evangelized and called to share in the Lord's joy and his kingdom (cf. Mt 5:3).

There are many ongoing efforts you can participate in to alleviate poverty in our area. Area food pantries, shelters, hospitals, parishes, and schools would love to help you share your gifts of time and talent and offer ways you can fulfill your philanthropic goals.


