

HEALTH NOTES

Not All Memory Loss Is a Sign of Dementia

People of all ages suffer memory loss at times and lapses in memory may become more frequent as we age. Being unable to recall the name of your neighbor when you meet her on your way to work in the morning doesn't necessarily mean you're developing Alzheimer's.

If you are experiencing memory issues, the first thing to do is see your doctor. A complete medical evaluation may uncover an underlying cause for the symptoms you're having – a cause that may be treatable.

Treatable causes include:

- Anxiety/stress
- A poor diet
- Drug side effects and interactions
- Infections
- Depression
- Thyroid disease
- Dehydration

Memory loss is not a "natural part of growing older." Geriatricians now recognize that dementia is part of a disease process. So, if you're experiencing symptoms, the first step is to rule out other, treatable conditions.


Shalom,






New Memorial Option in our Bulletin


