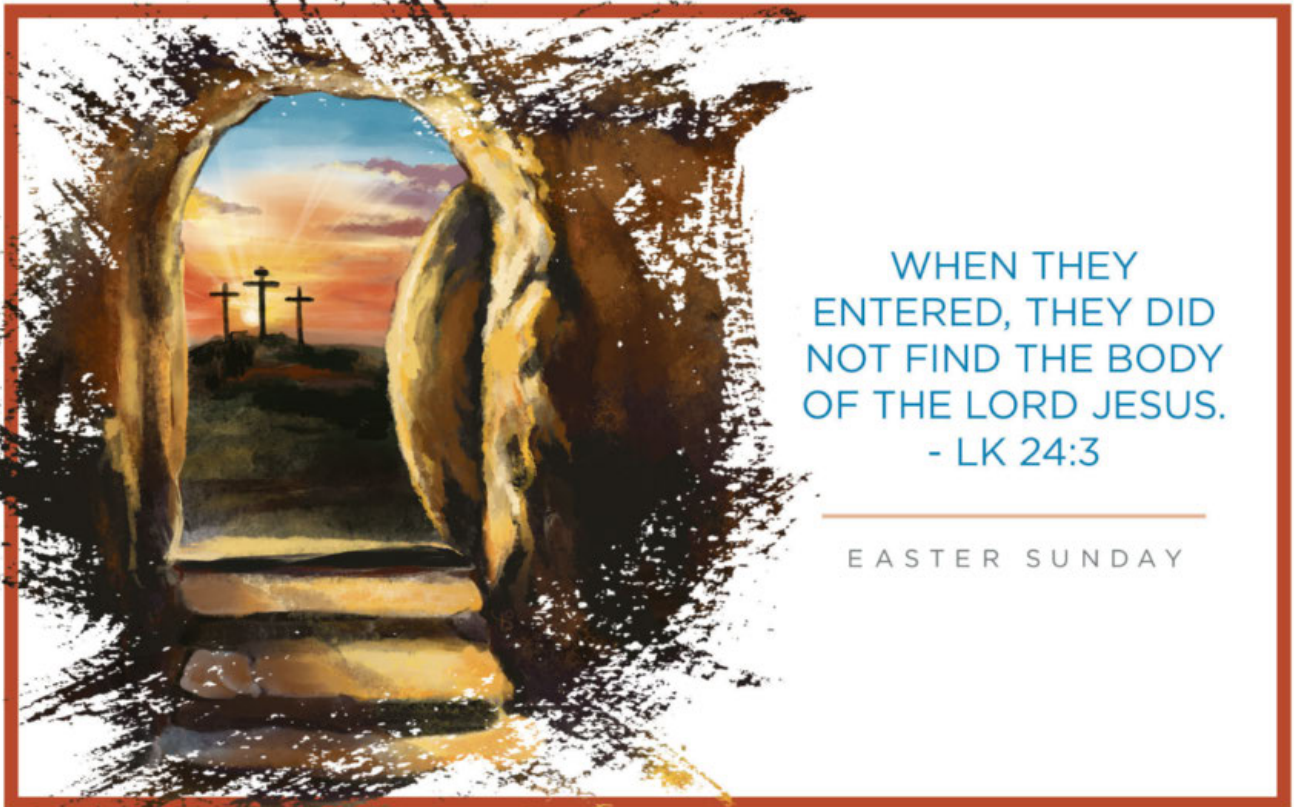

### PARKINSON AWARENESS MONTH

Parkinson's disease (PD) is a progressive neurological condition that affects more than one million people in the United States. Approximately 60,000 people are newly diagnosed each year. Onset commonly occurs after age 50; however, up to 10% of individuals with PD will receive an earlier diagnosis and are considered "young onset."

People with PD experience movement (motor) problems including slowness, rigidity, and tremor. Balance and gait problems may occur as the disease progresses. Some people may also experience decreased facial expression, low voice volume, small handwriting, and difficulty with fine motor movements. Several non-motor symptoms are associated with PD, including depression and other emotional changes; difficulty in swallowing, chewing, and speaking; urinary problems or constipation; skin problems; and sleep disruptions. It is important to understand that symptoms vary from person to person.

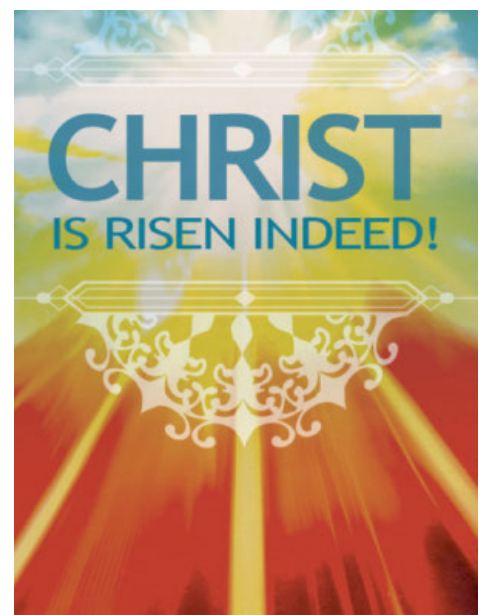
