Care and Share Ministry



SOCIAL CONCERNS NOTES

The \$2,500 grant to St. Michael's Food Pantry in Keshena for fresh meat and vegetables has been fully collected. Thank you for your generosity!

Please prayerfully consider offering your time and talent to our Christian Formation program!



We invite all the young people who made their First Holy Communion this spring to come to Mass dressed in their First Communion attire. They will process into church during the opening song with Fr. Dave. Each child will have a flower for Mary. We will have this procession at each of the weekend Masses May 7 & 8.



HEALTH NOTES

The Importance of CPR

Each year, more than 350,000 EMS-assessed out-of-hospital cardiac arrests occur in the United States. When a person has a cardiac arrest, survival depends on immediately receiving CPR from someone nearby. According to the American Heart Association, about 90 percent of people who suffer out-of-hospital cardiac arrests die. CPR, especially if performed immediately, can double, or triple a cardiac arrest victim's chance of survival.

If you are called on to give CPR in an emergency, you will most likely be trying to save the life of someone you love. The importance is on the willingness of bystanders to act in a cardiac arrest emergency. Did you know about 70 percent of out-of-hospital cardiac arrests happen in homes? If you are called on to give CPR in an emergency, you will most likely be trying to save the life of someone you love. Be the difference for your parent, spouse, child, family-member, friend, or co-worker. What if it were you?

Take 90 Seconds to learn how to save a life. Visit www.heart.org/handsonlycpr to watch the Hands-Only CPR instructional video and share it with the important people in your life. Hands-Only CPR is a natural introduction to CPR, and the AHA encourages everyone to learn conventional CPR as a next step. You can find a CPR class near you at www.heart.org/findacourse.
