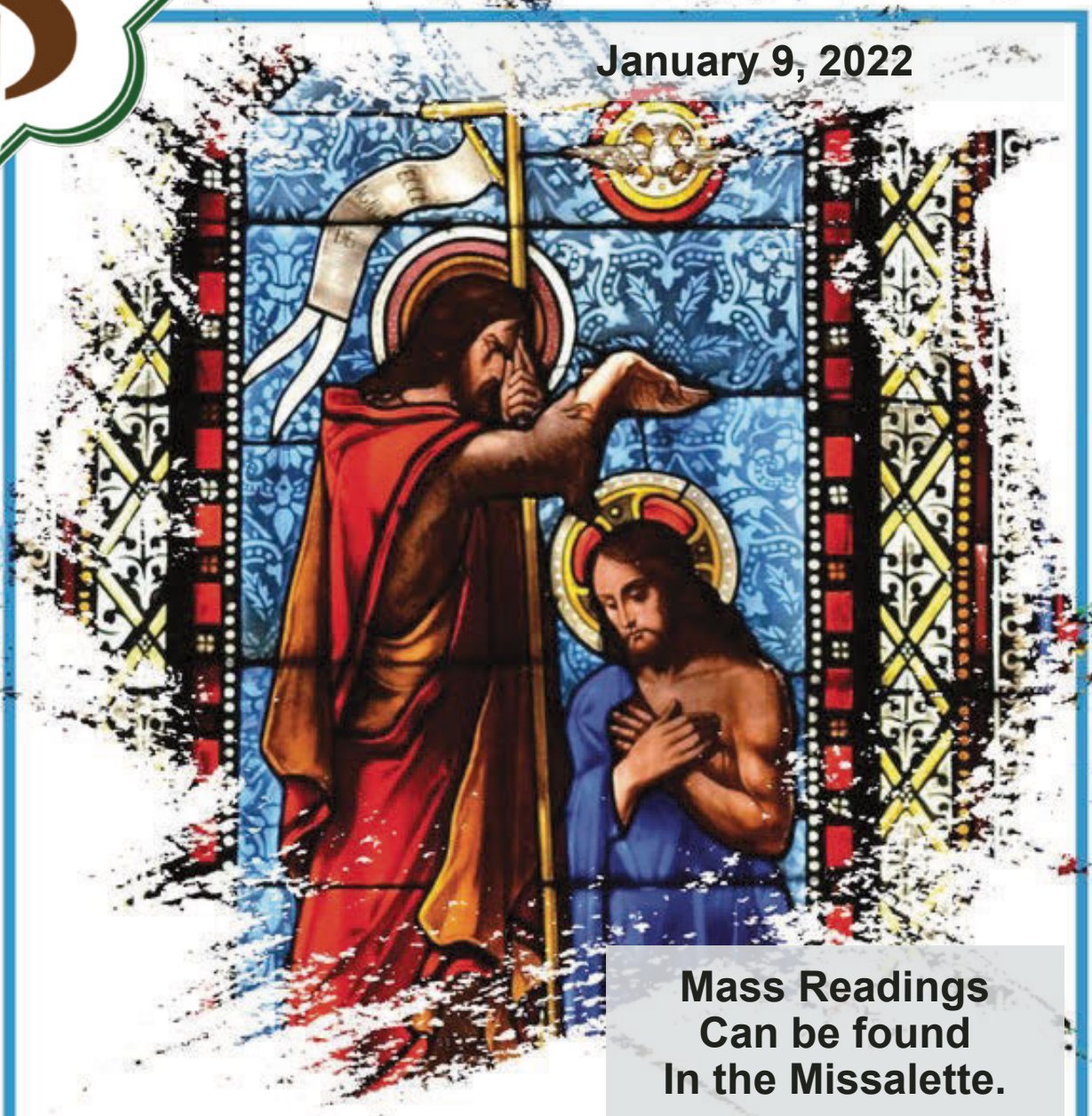

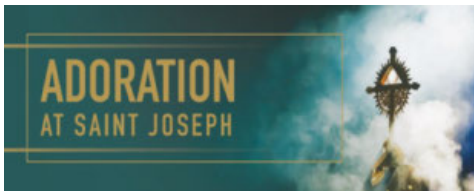

# EVERYDAY STEWARDSHIP

## I HOPE I AM LIKE HIM

“Who is this Christ? Is he like you?”

Perhaps you’ve heard this story, often attributed to the life of St. Teresa of Calcutta. A sick man asked her this question, as he marveled at her tireless service to himself and others in the name of someone named Jesus Christ.

“He is nothing like me,” the saint is said to have answered. “But I hope I am like him.”

Though the authenticity of this exchange cannot be verified, its message rings perfectly true: all the value of our stewardship lies in its relativity to the one in whose name we perform it.

Consider the figure of John the Baptist — a magnificent, towering character even purely from a literary or historical perspective. A martyr who fed on wild locusts and boldly spoke

truth to power — a man so great some mistook him for the Messiah.

But why is he great? Because he prepared the way. All his accomplishments and escapades mean nothing if they are taken out of the context of salvation history. He only makes sense relative to Christ — and this is exactly as he wanted it. “One worthier than I is coming,” he insists. And because of that humility and that total embrace of God’s will, he is given one of the greatest honors in the New Testament — he baptizes the Son of God.

Let’s examine our lives in the light of their relativity to Christ. How do we prepare the way? When Christ comes to us, what do we do? How do we leave ourselves open to be actors in God’s plan?

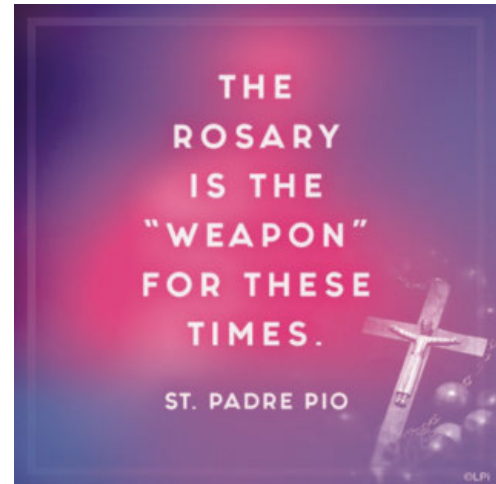
## Rosary 101

## **LOOKING AT 2021 WE NEED TO SAY "THANK YOU"**

These two words cannot be shared enough with the people of Saint Joseph. You have excelled during the challenges of 2021. So, we say it again, Thank You.

Looking back, we started 2021 with Social Distancing, ropes on the pews in church and face masks. The first half of the year we had few in person meetings or programs as we followed the guidance of the CDC and the Diocese. We started the year with streaming, Facebook Live, YouTube, and Zoom as words added to our vocabulary. In true Saint Joseph/German character you made it work. Thank you.

March 20 was the first Parish Landscape Day. Lead by our Holy Trinity Community, the families of Saint Joseph knocked it out of the park. They had the flower beds and plantings cleaned and mulched in just a few hours. This saved the Parish thousands of dollars. Some even dared to say they enjoyed it! Thank you goes to those that gave generously of their time.

In April and May our Renovation became real. Phase II of the exterior renovation began. Looking back it was amazing to see the contractors at work and even more, to see the final result. Recalling the scaffolding on the bell tower will be a point of conversation for years to come. We ended 2021 with the majority of the exterior masonry work complete.

The other event that made the renovation real was the start of the Capital Campaign. With a goal of \$10 million, we have met over 94% of that goal in a few short months. The renovation, restoration and repair of the building and the completion of the Capital Campaign is a gift from you to the future generations that will attend and worship at Saint Joseph. Again, we say, Thank You.

On a parish wide basis, the transition of Mass to Kundek Hall was a milestone last experienced in the 1950s. The planning and preparation were several months in the making. Father Eugene stated he wanted a place that would be prayerful, comfortable and familiar... while spending as little as possible. The response from the people of Saint Joseph was overwhelming. Every work session ended early and the volunteers met all of the objectives plus some items planned for the next session.

On August 30, 2021 several hundred people attended the 8:00 AM Mass and then processed to Kundek Hall. Many were able to remain as the Blessed Sacrament was then available for Adoration. The morning was reported both in local news, Evansville Television and our Diocese Newspaper - *The Message*. Following this a troop of Parishioners physically completed the move of everything from the Sacristy, Balcony, Nave, and Sanctuary to the Parish Center.

The next morning was equally impressive as some of the men of our parish started the disassembly of the pews. The pew ends were separated from the other parts to be shipped for refit and construction of new pews that will better serve our family. We would be remiss if we did not acknowledge the members of surrounding parishes that joined in this work.

Thank you to all that made the success of 2021 possible. There are many more people and events that have benefited Saint Joseph and our community. We will share these stories over the next few weeks.

As we look to the year ahead we invite you to consider how you can give the gift of service. Watch for opportunities in the bulletin and elsewhere.

GOSPEL MEDITATION - ENCOURAGE DEEPER UNDERSTANDING OF SCRIPTURE

The Baptism of the Lord

*"We are called to live our baptism every day, as new creatures, clothed in Christ."*

— Pope Francis

What reference point do you use when making decisions? Many times, impulse takes control and decisions are made based solely on emotion and desire. We all know that these types of decisions can often get us into trouble. When a person has a confident sense of who they are and a real understanding of what is important and of value, the likelihood of kneejerk impulsive choices diminishes. Baptism gives us what we need to make well informed and purposeful decisions. By this simple gesture, God claims us as His own and provides us with the identity and purpose we need to properly live life.

It is tremendously reassuring, when we truly embrace this revelation and realize that we no longer have to wonder about the purpose of our lives or struggle to find our way. The answer of who we are in God has been given to us. We no longer have to fumble around, trip over ourselves

or walk aimlessly about. Issues surrounding the sacredness of life, the meaning of death, the protection of those most vulnerable, care for the weak and the poor, offering hospitality to those in search of a home, the purpose and proper place of work, how to create a just social order, caring for creation, and understanding our roles as heralds and stewards are just a few of the wonderful gifts baptism brings. When we make decisions based on things such as these core Gospel truths we really act as Christ himself, revealing to others the new creations that we are. This is how we live our baptism.

It is difficult to walk against the tide. Yet, that is precisely what baptism calls us to do. Although we are sinners, in need of mercy and far from perfection we are called to order our life and make decisions based upon the wisdom and guidance of Almighty God. He alone is the one who can claim us as His sons and daughters. Standing up for our principles will not make us popular. But who ever said Christianity is a popularity contest? Baptism calls us to stand up for that which goes against the grain of secularism. Standing in line with other sinners, we have our anchor to steady us in the tempests of life and God is very pleased. Forge ahead. There is nothing to fear.
