Greetings,

I want to write about the results of the parish council elections. We have elected Jason Nord, Jane Fischer, and Tara Dreblow for a three-year term. I thank Dana Bachman and Nathan Bradford for their interest. I also thank Jason Nord, Maggie Schneider, and Luke Messmer for their three years on the parish council. They were involved with many projects during their three years. Jason will continue for another term. This past week, Jason, Jane and Tara attended their first meeting. Parish Council officers will be elected from the at-large members. I ask for your prayers for the parish council as we begin with a new team.

A few weeks ago, I wrote about the mosaics, a chair lift, and the church doors. I can report on the mosaics and the timeline for the assessment. They will begin on Monday, September 23rd by erecting the scaffolding for the center Mosaic above the back high altar. This will take them two days to assemble, and we will have daily Masses on those days in Kundek Hall. The mosaic artists will begin assessing the center mosaic throughout the first week, until Monday or Tuesday of the next week. Alan Hoffman is working with Michael Eagan, the architect from the past church renovation, on these projects. They contacted a firm from New York and another one from Italy to give us an assessment and an estimate for the center Mosaic. They want to erect the scaffolding about six inches away from the Mosaic to get a close-up view. They will give us an estimate for the mosaics on the side altars as well. After their evaluation, the scaffolding will be taken down, and the church will return to normal on the weekend of October 5th and 6th. On the days that the scaffolding goes up or comes down, we will have daily Masses in Kundek Hall. We do not yet know if we will be in church for daily Mass on the days they will be doing the assessments. We will only use Kundek through the week. On the weekend, we will return to the church. I was told that the mosaics were updated during Fr. Ray's time here, and it made a major difference. He had Joe Helming wash them by spraying water on them. They were only cleaned. Probably, wiping them would weaken and dislodge some of the material.

We visited a church in Gentryville that had a chair lift from the basement to the first floor (about 14 steps) and the stairs had a curve. We rode on it and timed how long the cycle took to go up and back. It was a heavy-duty chair lift, and it was steady. Our choir loft has 40 more steps than this church, so it would take longer to reach the top and return. Each trip, up and back, totaled 2 minutes. I would estimate it will take 6-8 minutes in our church, so it will not be a fast trip. But for someone who cannot do the steps, it is an opportunity. The chair lift can be locked out. We will review more information on these lifts before making a decision. Our group has not met to discuss the doors of the church.

Pope Francis announced the IV World Day for Grandparents and Elderly to be Sunday July 28, 2024. The U.S. bishops approved the transfer of the celebration of this observance to the first Sunday after Labor Day, Sunday, September 8. This coincides with the national celebration of Grandparents Day in the United States, which many local communities, schools, and parishes observe. The theme chosen by the Holy Father is, "Do not cast me off in my old age." (Psalm 71:9) He wishes to call attention to the fact that, sadly, loneliness is the bitter lot in the lives of many elderly, so often the victims of the throw-away culture. He has invited everyone "to show our tender love for grandparents and the elderly members of our families." A plenary indulgence is granted to Catholics across the United States who observe the World Day for Grandparents and Elderly, under the usual conditions, on September 8, 2024. (Committee on Laity, Marriage, Family Life, and Youth).

St. Joseph Parish has many ministries involved and connected with particular needs of parishioners and loved ones. Our parish has been blessed for many years through the work of the Stephen Ministry program. Ministers have a particular gift from God that can help others in similar needs. These members go through training on how to serve those who are suffering. St. Joseph was one the first parishes to start a Stephen Ministry program. Over the years, ministers age, and they switch places while recruitment for the ministry is very low. The Stephen Ministry program at St. Joseph will be coming to an end due to no future recruits or leaders. I invite you to pray for this ministry. I will write more next week.

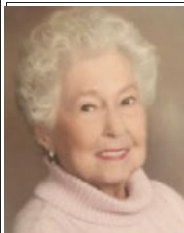

Neighbor to Neighbor in Jasper

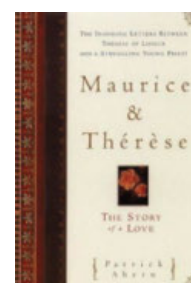

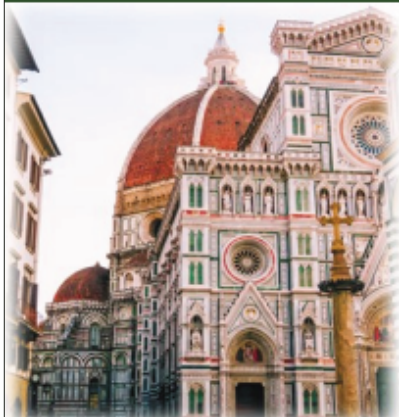
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
