

The Serra Club is a global lay apostolate dedicated to promoting vocations to the Priesthood and Religious life. Many parishes in the St. Louis Archdiocese, with the help of the Serra Club, have adopted a creative way to inspire greater prayer for vocations by beginning "Travelling Chalice Programs."

The purpose of the Chalice Program is to encourage families to develop a daily habit to pray and promote vocations. Hosting the Consecrated Chalice in one's home is a tangible reminder to all the members of the family of this special intention for the Church. Everyone is aware that the shortage of priests is a growing crisis within the Catholic Church. We Catholics need good and holy priests to bring us Jesus in the Eucharist. When we pray for vocations, we lift up to our Father those men and women whom He is calling to follow Him in a very special way. Our hope is that those families who bring the Chalice home will continue to pray daily for vocations. St. Barnabas the Apostle Parish is currently on a waiting list to receive our Chalice sometime after the first of the year. Here's how the program works:


- Fill out the form below and drop it into the collection. Your family will be put on a list. If there are upcoming weeks that you know you will be unable to participate or a special week you would like to be blessed with the Chalice in your home, please indicate that information on the form.
- Check the bulletin for a list of families and dates in early January.
- Each week, an assigned family receives the Chalice after Sunday Mass along with suggested prayers. The family takes the Chalice home and displays the Chalice on their home altar or in a prominent visible area and prays daily for an increase of religious vocations during that week.
- If you would like to write a short letter or card of encouragement to a seminarian, the office will forward the letters to Kenrick-Glennon Seminary at the beginning of each month.
- On the next Sunday, family returns the chalice to the sacristy prior to the Sunday morning Mass. The next family will take the Chalice home after Mass.
- If the priest is available after Mass, he will be asked to give your family a blessing and a picture will taken for the bulletin if you would like to do so.




The First meeting of our new book club went very well. It was a unanimous decision that we meet every other Tuesday beginning January 11th after the Christmas holidays



What are Sacramentals?

In addition to the Seven Sacraments, the Catholic Church has instituted sacramentals.

Sacramentals are sacred signs, objects or actions, that the Church uses after the manner of sacraments, in order to achieve through the merits of the faithful certain effects, mainly of a spiritual nature.

Sacramentals differ from sacraments in not having been instituted by Christ to produce their effect in virtual of the ritual performed. Sacramental efficacy depends not on the rite itself, as in the sacraments, but on the influence of prayerful petition; that of the person who used them and of the Church in approving their practice.
