

### Wednesday February 2nd

Feast of the Purification of the Blessed Virgin Mary

On February 2nd, Catholics mark the presentation of Child Jesus in the temple and the Purification of the Blessed Virgin Mary. Another name for the feast day is Candlemas Day. You may bring candles for Father Schumacher to bless.




Mary and Joseph brought Jesus to the temple for the rites of purification and dedication as prescribed by the Torah.

According to the Book of Leviticus (12:1-4), when a woman bore a male child, she was considered "unclean" for seven days. On the eighth day, the boy was circumcised. The mother continued to stay at home for 33 days for her blood to be purified. After the 40 days, the mother and the father came to the temple for the rite of purification, which included the offering of a sacrifice – a lamb for a holocaust (burnt offering) and a pigeon or turtledove for a sin offering, or for a poor couple who could not afford a lamb, two pigeons or two turtledoves. The Feast of the Presentation officially closes the celebration of Christmas.


A little tidbit: Candlemas Day was important in the lives of farmers. An old English song went as follows: If Candlemas be fair and bright, Come, Winter, have another flight. If Candlemas brings clouds and rain, Go, Winter, and come not again.

So if the bright sun "overshadows" the brightness of Candlemas Day, there will be more winter. However, if the light of Candlemas Day radiates through the gloom and darkness of the day, the end of winter is near.
