A Faith That Refuses to Give Up

The Gospel this weekend (cf. Matthew 15:21-28) introduces us to a woman who refuses to walk away from Jesus. She is a Canaanite, an outsider by every social and religious standard. Yet she approaches the Lord with one simple plea: "Have pity on me." She is not asking for herself but for her daughter, whose suffering has become her own.

At first, Jesus seems silent. Then His words appear surprisingly harsh. It is a passage that can make us uncomfortable. But the woman's response is remarkable. She does not become angry, nor does she lose hope. Instead, she answers with humility and unwavering trust: "Even the dogs eat the scraps that fall from their masters' table."

Jesus is not rejecting her; He is revealing the depth of her faith. In the end, He praises her with words spoken to very few people in the Gospels: "O woman, great is your faith!" Her daughter is healed because her faith persevered.

How often have we prayed and felt that God was silent? How many times have we wondered if He was listening? This Gospel reminds us that silence is not absence. God's timing is often different from ours, but His love never fails.



The Canaanite woman teaches us that faith is not measured by how quickly our prayers are answered, but by our willingness to keep trusting when the answer has not yet come. She reminds us to bring our burdens, our families, and our hearts to Christ again and again.

May we never grow weary in prayer. The Lord hears every cry, knows every need, and, in His perfect time, responds with a love greater than we can imagine.

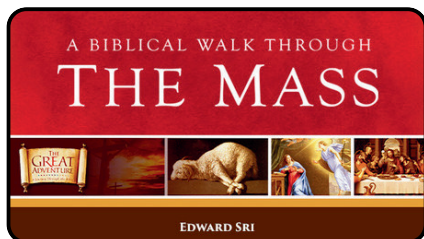
2026/2027 CCLC PASTORAL COUNCIL MEMBER ANNOUNCEMENT

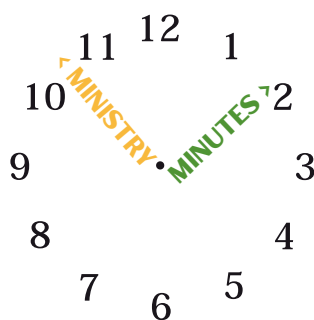

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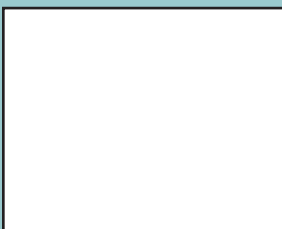
