FITNESS CENTER

The Waupun Senior Center has 14 resistance fitness machines and a cabinet of handheld weights, resistance bands, and exercise balls. We will show you how to use each piece of equipment. MONDAY YOGA I

Chair support is offered for standing and seated yoga poses. This class focuses on stretching your whole body by focusing on specific muscle and muscle groups. This is a 45 minute class. Please wear tennis shoes.

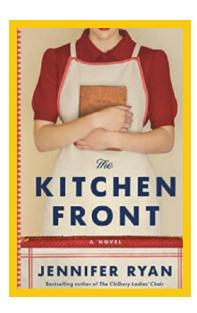
KNIT-WITS

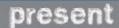

WE ARE WISCONSIN DRUG REPOSITORY

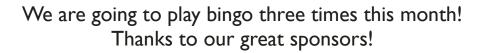
Church Health Services, Inc. is seeking unused/ unneeded medicines and medical supplies. You may be able to help us or receive free:
