How Is the Day of the Dead Celebrated? Halloween? All Saints Day?El Día de los Muertos is not, as is commonly thought, a Mexican version of <u>Halloween</u>, though the two holidays do share some traditions, including costumes and parades. On the Day of the Dead, it's believed that the border between the spirit world and the real world dissolve. During this brief period, the souls of the dead awaken and return to the living world to feast, drink, dance and play music with their loved ones. In turn, the living family members treat the deceased as honored guests in their celebrations, and leave the deceased's favorite foods and other offerings at gravesites or on the *ofrendas* built in their homes. *Ofrendas* can be decorated with candles, bright marigolds called *cempasuchil* and red cock's



- <u>Must call 24 hours in advance to book a ride (weekdays only)</u>, phone calls need to be received between 8 am and 4:15 pm the day before the ride you desire. 262.253.7799
- Must reside in the village for ride pick up
- When you make a reservation, please have the address of where you are going, where you are being picked up and your phone number.
- You are charged according to the mileage involved in the trip there and back
- We try to get as close to your desired time as possible, <u>please be on time as we book many</u> rides a day.
- Must be 55 years of age or older to use this service.
- Driver's cannot enter passengers home, a rider must be able to get out to the van on their own or have a caregiver with them.
- We cannot transport people home from the hospital or ER after a procedure,
- We also cannot transport large items in the van such as furniture, televisions etc.


