

PASTOR'S CORNER

INSPIRED BY THE SPIRIT

Our parishes pride themselves as a place of welcome to all. It is a place where our parishioners can practice their Catholic faith and grow in service to our community and beyond. In keeping with that spirit, we can look to the future and make preparations in order to help St. Anthony de Padua and St Thomas thrive for the generations of tomorrow. Thanks to the great leadership of our bishop, bishop Callahan, who is helping all parishes in this regard through Inspired by the Spirit Campaign. The main focus of this Inspired by the Spirit Campaign is the strengthening of each individual parish in an effort to provide a bright future for generations to come. Here in St. Anthony and St. Thomas our goal is set at \$340,000 and \$65,000 respectively, of which 65% will be returned to our parishes. This campaign has a 5-year redemption period. As you consider your pledge, take into account that whatever you pledge can be paid over 5 years. In the month of September we shall launch this campaign in our Church. But before then, there are some parishioners who have received letters from me to call me to schedule an appointment with me. Some have called me and we have had very fruitful conversation. If you have not called me, please do call me to schedule an appointment, either for me to come to your house or you come to the rectory.

Again, there is no Diocesan Annual Appeal in the year 2022/23 fiscal year.

I want to make this one point; we should know that we can never outdo God's generosity towards us. So in your sacrifice to God, consider how much you are blessed. You are not paying God for his blessings on you but rather showing your appreciation to him.

I will now leave you with the words of St. Paul: "Let me say this much; He who sows sparingly will reap sparingly, and he who sows bountifully will reap bountifully. Everyone must give according to what he has inwardly decided; not sadly, not grudgingly, for God loves a cheerful giver. God can multiply his favors among you so that you may always have enough of everything and even a surplus for good works". (2 Cor. 9:6-8)

May God continue to bless our Church and our families.


