



We celebrate Father's Day today and I wish all fathers well in their continuing journey of raising their children. Father figures are important.

You may be familiar with this quote that said "Any man can be a father. It takes someone special to be a Dad."

Today is about those men who not only fathered children but became Dads to their children, and fathered them in a way that gave them a real lease on life. Today we celebrate fathers who have chosen to love and understand, protect and encourage, in the way God, the father of Jesus does. Jesus used the image of the father as a way of helping people see God in more familiar terms, helping people to love God and to know that they are loved – rather than merely to fear God, or to think about God, as a substitute for relating to God in a more dynamic way. Hope all the men who bear this responsibility in their life are appreciated and blessed by God the Father.

Today's gospel is about the miracle of Jesus calming the stormy river. Some of the lessons in the story are obvious. Jesus has power over the storms of life, experiences them alongside us, loves us, saves us from them, and wants us to trust him more than we do.

Let's look at a lesson that might not be so obvious. Storms don't worry Jesus. He's right there with us during them, but he's perfectly calm about them. He isn't terrified; he isn't impatient; he isn't worried. In fact, he is so calm, he's asleep. We wonder why on earth he doesn't get up and do something. We start to wonder whether he even knows the trouble we are in, whether he cares, whether he even can do anything about it.

Like the disciples, we believe he is there. In the disciples' case, they could actually see him lying there asleep. We don't have that luxury. We believe he's there, but most of the time he seems just as asleep as he was during the storm that day on the sea of Galilee.

The not-so-obvious lesson is that Jesus was just as much in control, and the disciples were just as safe in his hands, while he was asleep as while he was awake. Most of the time, life seems like a relentless voyage from one storm to the next. The crises of life have often been compared to stormy seas. They come upon us whether we like it or not. They terrify us. They knock us around and threaten to destroy all our stability and security. We don't know whether we can survive them. And we don't know how long they will last. At least, that's how a storm at sea would be for most of us.

The image of Jesus in the boat has always been understood as an image of the Church. Sometimes the church experiences violent storms, great waves smashing the boat, the feeling of sinking and disaster. Cries and prayers have gone up to Jesus throughout history.

What waves can you name entering the boat of your life? Which attitude lives in your heart, fear or trust?

As Jesus commands, so can you in prayerful union with Jesus command "Quiet. Be still". Can you be truly quiet and still, at peace, conscious of living in the world of God's presence?

Are you in a storm now? There is no calm like the calm Christ brings when he speaks peace to your storm-tossed soul. This Jesus in your boat will bring you safely into the harbor. He has not promised a calm journey, but he will give a safe arrival. He will not leave you in the storm but will bring you safely to land. You will not perish.

I would like to share a quick story and a powerful lesson with you...

There was an elderly woman who needed to walk down to the river every morning to get water for drinking, cooking and cleaning. She carried two buckets with her which she filled up at the river bank, and walked back with them to her little rural cottage. One of the buckets was newer and held its water well, but the second bucket was older and had a few thin cracks that would leak water onto the ground as the elderly woman walked. By the time she arrived back at her home, typically about one-third of the water in the second bucket had leaked through its cracks.

One day, on the walk down to the river, the cracked bucket, who had always felt like it wasn't as good as the other bucket, said to the elderly woman, "I want you to know that I've been leaking water every morning for the past several years. I'm so sorry for being cracked and making your life more difficult. I understand if you need to replace me with a newer, better bucket."

The elderly woman smiled. "Do you really think I haven't known about your cracks this whole time?" she asked. "Look at all the beautiful flowers that grow on the path from my cottage to the river. I planted their seeds, but every morning it's you who does the watering."

Remember: Feeling "good enough" in life, work, business, and in our relationships has everything to do with how we personally judge the cracks in our own bucket. Because we all have a few cracks! But are they cracks that wreck us, taint us, and ruin our experience and desirability? Or do our cracks water a trail of flowers we haven't even stopped to appreciate?

Choose to see the flowers through the cracks in your own bucket — choose to see how it is exactly those cracks that make you good enough! *Deacon Dave*




