Salt for the Weak



"You're not listening to me!" A seemingly universal experience is when we don't feel as if we're being heard. I think there's a sense that we don't have to have someone agree with us, but we do want to be heard. Folks

on the street will say "Do you feel me?" And whether you're a parent, teacher, coach, spouse or best friend, you know how frustrating it is when someone just won't listen. The more we care, the more frustrating it is.

This weekend we have the wonderful gospel account of the transfiguration of Jesus. But don't let all the awe and wonder and glory overshadow the three most significant words (I think): "Listen to him."

Do I really *listen* to God? How do I know? How do I try? And if we know how frustrating it is when someone doesn't listen to US, I wonder how God feels? Let's focus these Lenten days on living In Christ Alone, and especially in trying to be a better listener.

Maybe that's why there are the same letters in listen and silent.



So, we're one week into Lent—what's different? It is so easy to get into a "hamster-like" existence, merry-go-round living and not take time to break the cycle. What have you done to reflect on living more "In Christ Alone"? Small changes are the easiest and sometimes the most effective. Turn off the music in your vehicle. Pray all or part of a Rosary when on the road. Rarely pray before meals?—start now. Don't pray in the morning?—try asking for help and guidance when you're brushing your teeth. Forget to pray at night? Write "Thank You!" on something or place a thank you card on your bedside stand or on top of your phone. Tell Christ your gratitudes of the day. Prone to snack or go to the refrigerator more than you should? Write UKRAINE on small cards and place them on the door of your snack cupboard or on the refrigerator. Offer a prayer and skip the snack. Every parish has an afternoon Holy Hour with the Blessed Sacrament and Stations of the Cross during the week—that's FIVE chances! Take one. Change your schedule and go and pray. Visit someone you know will talk forever. Go to daily Mass. Phone someone you've been avoiding. Come to weekend worship earlier and sit and prepare by looking at the readings. Ask Jesus into your heart in a deeper way so that you can live more fully "In Christ Alone." Make a change this week.
