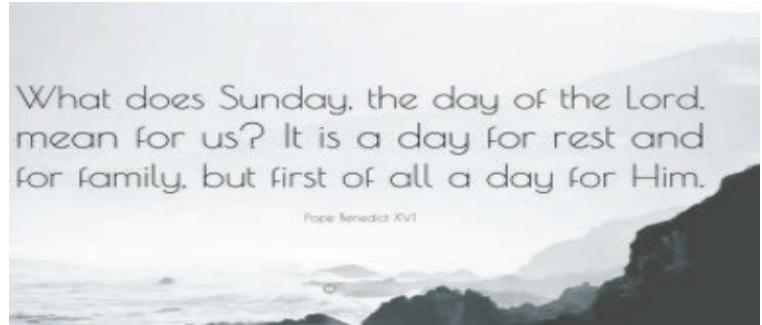

**A Word From Our Pastor**



Dear All,

Time is a prized commodity. We are a people governed by a clock. Time is money. The last thing any of us want to do is waste time.

We now enter into Ordinary Time in our liturgical year(33-34 weeks). I always love saying that Ordinary time is our journey through the extraordinary mystery of our God. When time was created, the Creator also rested from all of the work in the first six days. We cannot speak of Ordinary Time without speaking about Sunday. From all of the creative and life-giving Word and work of our Creator, He rested to enjoy the beauty and wonder of creation. That is exactly what the Church is calling us to do during Ordinary Time. Sunday celebration of the Eucharist and the community gathering is to enjoy the wonder and awe of God’s love and to be renewed, rejuvenated for the six days ahead. The celebration of the Sunday Eucharist is the identifying mark of the Catholic Community. Sunday Eucharist is remembering that the Lord of Life was raised up on the first day of the week and creation came, at last, to its completion. How we live Sunday proclaims what we believe about redeemed time now and forever. Sunday, like all of the Sacraments, is simultaneously a point of arrival and departure for all Catholic Christians. I think it is fair to say this is not ordinary at all. Sunday becomes part of the fabric of Christian living.

I know the pandemic has gotten in the way of our gathering. Many people are hesitant to gather in large groups, in small spaces. Understandable. Remember there is a live-streamed Mass every Sunday from OLOL or hundreds of other places throughout the world.

I also know that so many of our fellow Catholics do not see Sunday as the day of rest and worship of our loving God. Other gods (fill in the blank) have taken His place. I pray all of our parishioners recognize that all good gifts we have come from a loving God. It is to be with Him that we gather and see Him in one another. I know if we put God first in our Sunday there is plenty of time left over for the ordinary things of our life. May Ordinary time be extraordinary in loving our God in Jesus Christ.
