

### **2022 ELECTION YEAR**

There will be several elections in 2022. There could possibly be a Spring Primary Election on Tuesday, February 15, 2022, but we will not know about that until the deadline to file papers and that is Tuesday, January 4, 2022 at 5:00 p.m. The other elections are: April 5; August 16 and November 8, 2022.

If you are not registered to vote in the Town of Mukwonago, you may come to the Clerk's Office between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. Monday – Friday to register or go to <a href="http://myvote.wi.gov">http://myvote.wi.gov</a> and register on-line. If you have had a name change or a change of address within the Town of Mukwonago since the last time you voted, you will need to re-register as well.

### TAX COLLECTION

Taxes will be collected by Citizens Bank in Mukwonago through 1/31/2022. The final tax payment, or second installment, is due July 31, 2022 and is paid to the Waukesha County Treasurer.

# **SNOW PLOWING SEASON**

With the snow fall fast approaching, I want to make a couple of comments which all residents should be made aware of, so if it happens to you, you will know why. If the snow falls on a Thursday, which is garbage collection day, DO NOT place your trash bins in the roadway. If they are placed in the roadway, the plow driver may not plow in front of your residence and/or driveway as they don't want to be plowing up the trash bins. So PLEASE make sure the trash bins are out of the way of the snow plows.

Also PLEASE DO NOT BLOW THE SNOW INTO THE ROADWAY. If you blow your snow into the roadway and there is a complaint filed, it is possible you can get a citation for debris in the roadway, so please blow the snow off to the sides of your driveway. Also, DO NOT move your snow across the road and blow it or shovel it into someone else's property. That too, could result in a citation.

Happy New Year!!

As we spring forward into 2022, we are hopeful that you are able to join us for another safe, exciting start to a new year of activities! As always, safety and the well-being of our participants and their families remain critical in determining our overall success.

As challenging as 2021 proved to be, we are thankful for your continued support as we work to expand our offerings and staff within what is proving to be an extended pandemic... We are happy to announce that we will be growing by one, as we were able to budget for a full time Parks Maintenance Lead beginning in the spring.

With our excitement for the coming year noted, I would be remiss if I didn't note, as you browse through this guide, that we are hopeful that you find an activity (or two) to enjoy this coming spring... if not, we invite any and all suggestions as we are already working on additional programs for our Summer/Fall '22 offerings.



# YOUTH SPORTS REGISTRATION PROCEDURE

- New teams will be formed EVERY year.
- Youth sport teams will be organized based upon grade level. All levels of teams will be formed by a draft process with coaches.
- Team placement is final once draft is complete.
- You may request one "Team Friend or Sibling" on your registration form. "Team Friend or Sibling" MUST request each other on their registration form to be considered. Please make sure your friend/sibling is registered too.
- Due to team and practice night selection process, specific practice night requests cannot be guaranteed to be honored. If your assigned night does not meet your personal schedule, review the REFUND policy if it is necessary to withdraw your registration.
- Must sign Parent & Athlete Agreement.


