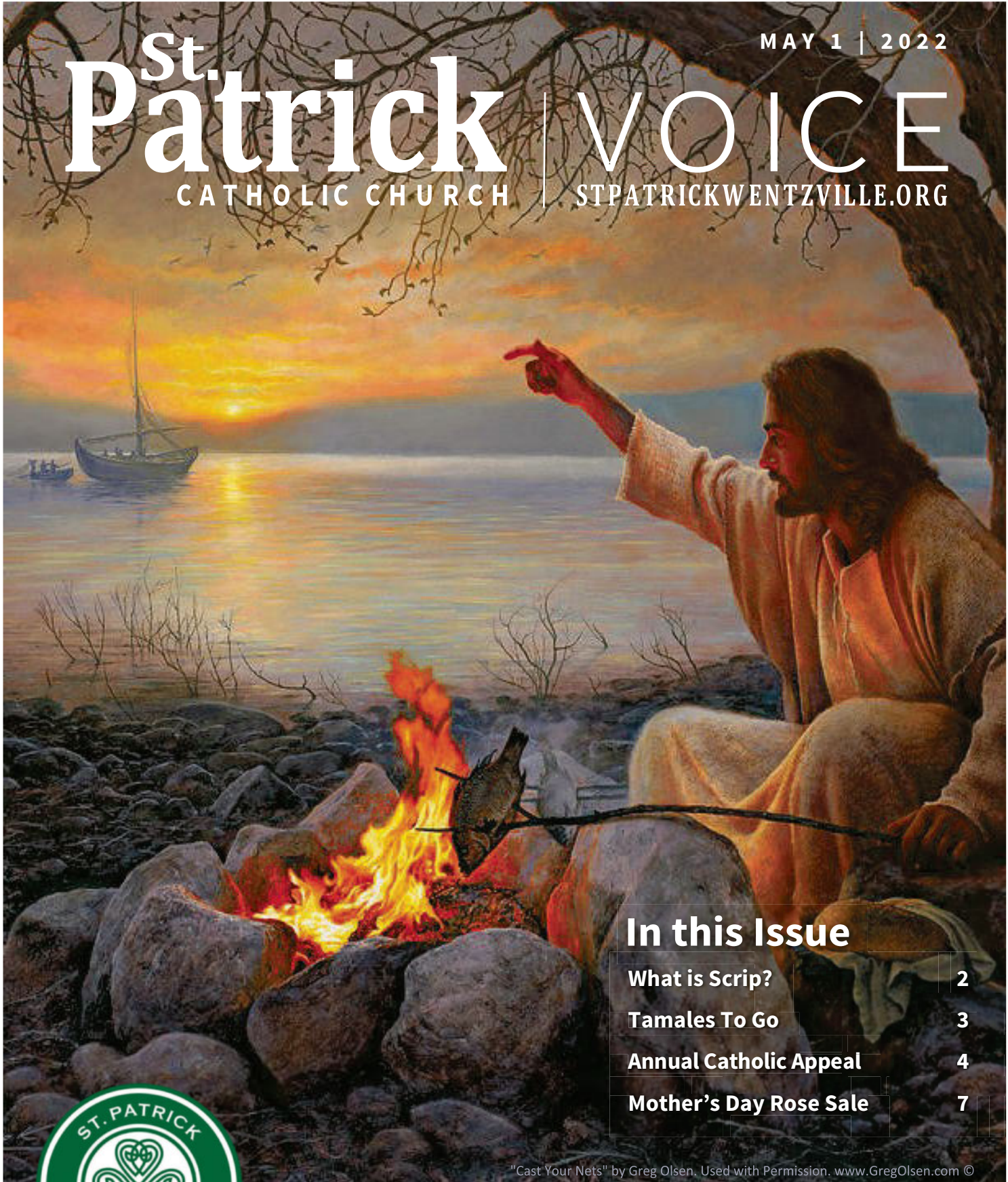

MASS INTENTIONS are accepted in the parish office.

What is Scrip?

Quite simply, Scrip means "substitute money". When you purchase Scrip, you're purchasing negotiable gift certificates and prepaid cards that are used just like cash. With every Scrip purchase, you earn money for St. Patrick at no additional cost to you. The vendor is the one who gives the parish a percentage of money. The amount you buy is the amount you get to spend. Then, you can decide where you would like your credits to go — full-time school, PSR, or the general parish fund. *Scrip is not just for school families. Anyone can participate.*

Scrip can be used for just about any household purchase, including food, clothing, entertainment, gasoline, vacations (including hotel/airfare), and restaurants. There are literally

hundreds of vendors who participate in the Scrip program.

Start earning today! Follow these simple steps to learn how get started with the Scrip program.

Step 1: Find brands you shop all the time. There are three ways to shop:

- RaiseRight mobile app
- Shop.ShopWithScrip.com
- Scrip Room/Parish Office

If ordering online, use enrollment code A5A792AA873L. To see the earning % offered by each brand, go to the brand's page or view the Scrip order form on our website.

Step 2: Choose either physical gift cards or eGift cards. Some physical gift cards are already available for purchase in the Scrip room or parish office. Visit www.stpatrickwentzville.org/scrip to see the listing of on-hand cards. If we do not

have the card on-hand, it can be shipped to the parish office for pick up or may be eligible to be shipped directly to your home. Note: Many physical gift cards can also be reloaded so you can keep using the ones you already have.

Step 3: Choose your payment method. There are three ways to pay:

- Link a bank account (online)
- Pay by credit card (online or in-person)
- Pay directly with cash or check (in person)

The success of the Scrip program depends on participation. The more people involved in purchasing Scrip, the more money we can earn for our parish and school.

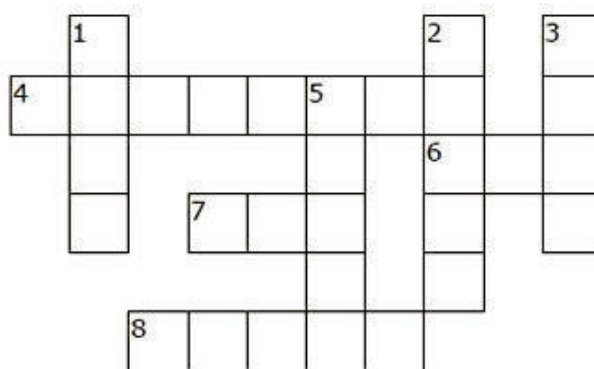

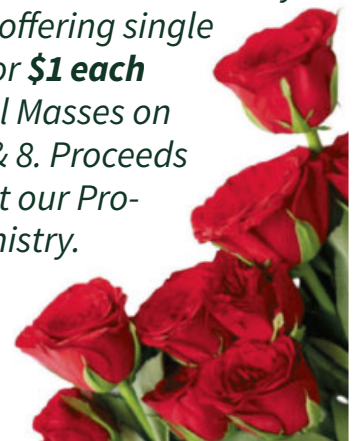
Bible Camp Volunteers

Did we ever stop and think that God is really and truly interested in the routine, run of the mill events of our lives? So, "what did you do today?" God may ask. Maybe we don't think that God is concerned about such things, or we are so consumed with life's demands that we give it little if any thought. Perhaps we are determined to achieve our own success, desire to control things ourselves or not really sure what God cares about. God is there. One day, out of the blue, God will get our attention and ask, "Do you love me?" ©LPi
