# What is Scrip?

Ouite simply. Scrip means "substitute money". When you purchase Scrip, you're purchasing negotiable gift certificates and prepaid cards that are used just like cash. With every Scrip purchase, vou earn money for St. Patrick at no additional cost to vou. The vendor is the one who gives the parish a percentage of money. The amount you buy is the amount you get to spend. Then, you can decide where you would like your credits to go - full-time school, PSR, or the general parish fund. Scrip is not just for school families. Anyone can participate.

Scrip can be used for just about any household purchase, including food, clothing, entertainment, gasoline, vacations (including hotel/airfare), and restaurants. There are literally







# **Inspiration** Live the Liturgy

What prevents us from seeing the Lord? We are not used to seeing Jesus in the ordinary, everyday events of our lives. We expect some kind of startling, extraordinary revelation to occur that definitely and unmistakably sends a signal that God wants our attention. We don't expect a visit from Jesus while we are having breakfast, doing the dishes, running after the kids, negotiating a deal at work, or taking a shower! 


