

WELCOME TO HOLY ROSARY PARISH

Dear Friends,

This weekend we begin the process of easing restrictions brought about by the Pandemic. Here is a summary of our next steps as outlined by the most recent recommendations of the Diocesan Reopening Committee:

Social-distancing is no longer required during Masses and other worship services, and face coverings and social distancing are no longer required for non-worship events and other gatherings on parish and diocesan property for those who have been fully vaccinated. ***Social-distancing and face coverings remain strongly encouraged for those who are not fully vaccinated.***

Also related, we received this notification from the Indiana Bishop's Conference:

Since March 2020, due to the outbreak of the COVID-19 pandemic, all Roman Catholics throughout the entire Province of Indianapolis, which comprises all five dioceses of Indiana, have been dispensed from the obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation. However, with the decrease of cases in our state, the widespread availability of vaccines and following the guidance of public health officials, we are now able to safely accommodate more parishioners for Masses. Therefore, **effective June 11**, the Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus, the general dispensation from the obligation to attend Mass is hereby lifted throughout the state of Indiana.

Except for the unique situations as described below, those who are otherwise healthy are obliged to return to Sunday Mass by the weekend of June 12-13, 2021:

- Those who are seriously ill, exhibit flu-like symptoms and/or may have a contagious disease (including quarantine due to exposure).
- Those who are unable to attend Mass through no fault of their own (e.g. transportation issue).
- Those who are homebound and/or incapacitated due to age, infirmity and/or medical restrictions.
- Those who have compromised health conditions and/or at high risk of contracting the virus.
- Those who are caretakers of person who are sick or of persons at high-risk of serious illness if they contract COVID-19 virus.

Queridos Amigos,

Este fin de semana comenzamos el proceso de flexibilización de las restricciones provocadas por la Pandemia. He aquí un resumen de nuestros próximos pasos, tal como se describen en las reco-

mendaciones más recientes del Comité Diocesano de Reapertura:

El distanciamiento social ya no es necesario durante las misas y otros servicios de adoración, y ya no se requieren coberturas faciales y distanciamiento social para los eventos de no adoración y otras reuniones sobre la propiedad parroquial y diocesana para aquellos que han sido vacunados completamente. ***Se sigue fomentando encarecidamente el distanciamiento social y las coberturas faciales para aquellos que no están totalmente vacunados.***

También relacionados, recibimos esta notificación de la Conferencia Episcopal de Indiana:

Desde marzo de 2020, debido al estallido de la pandemia COVID-19, todos los católicos romanos de toda la provincia de Indianápolis, que comprende las cinco diócesis de Indiana, han sido dispensados de la obligación de asistir a misa los domingos y días santos de obligación. Sin embargo, con la disminución de casos en nuestro estado, la disponibilidad generalizada de vacunas y siguiendo la guía de los funcionarios de salud pública, ahora podemos acomodar con seguridad a más feligreses para las misas. Por lo tanto, a partir del **11** de junio, la solemnidad del Santísimo Corazón de Jesús, la dispensa general de la obligación de asistir a la misa se levanta por la presente en todo el estado de Indiana.

A excepción de las situaciones únicas como se describe a continuación, aquellos que están sanos están obligados a regresar a la misa dominical para el fin de semana del 12 al 13 de junio de 2021:

- Aquellos que están gravemente enfermos, presentan síntomas similares a los de la gripe y/o pueden tener una enfermedad contagiosa (incluida la cuarentena debido a la exposición).
- Aquellos que no pueden asistir a misa sin culpa propia (por ejemplo, problema de transporte).
- Aquellos que están en casa y / o incapacitados debido a la edad, enfermedad y / o restricciones médicas.
- Aquellos que han comprometido las condiciones de salud y / o con alto riesgo de contraer el virus.
- Aquellos que son cuidadores de personas enfermas o de personas con alto riesgo de enfermedad grave si contraen el virus COVID-19.

To Love as Jesus Loves: An Easter Reflection

Excerpted from the 2021 book, *The Heart of the Mission: Simple Ways to Bring People to Jesus* by Cande de Leon, executive director for the Office of Mission Advancement, Diocese of Phoenix, published by Our Sunday Visitor. Cande will be a session presenter in the Stewardship, Engagement and Evangelization track at the 2021 ICSC Conference in Orlando, Florida.

Jesus has given each baptized Catholic a mission: “Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you” (Mt 28:19-20). Our mission is to live this calling every day of our lives. People are at the heart of the mission of the Church. Strengthening relationships, boldly growing engagement and connecting people to the mission are simple ways to bring people to Jesus. It is not complicated – we just need to bring people to Jesus. God is always drawing closer to us, so we can rest assured that he is the one doing the hard work – not us! In order to bring people to Jesus, we must start with loving and caring for people one at a time. It has to come from a genuine desire to love and show people that they matter. After all, why would anyone listen to the Good News from us, if we haven’t shown them God’s love? If we are all God’s children, then we have a responsibility to help each other. We are meant to live in relationship, and to be the living presence of God in the world – to show his love to the people around us. This means treating people like family, not transactions. It’s easy to do this with the people we enjoy being around. It’s a lot harder to put into practice when we are talking about a coworker or acquaintance who drives us crazy. But like it or not, we are all called to this. For me this is a revolutionary idea: I am not better than anyone else. The world tries to separate us all the time by putting us into categories of race, gender or socioeconomic status. Those don’t really matter. We are all children of God. It is important for all of us to try to see the people in front of us and love them like Jesus does. I invite you to join me in that, to strive each day to see people as your brothers and sisters and to treat them accordingly.



LIVE THE LITURGY

Inspiration for the week

The immensity, scope, intimacy, and pervasiveness of God's presence is too intense for the human mind. We often limit God by our expectations of Him and have a hard time just letting God be God. Some people all too easily lose faith because God does not meet their expectations. Worse still, the idea of faith is rejected altogether by others because of polarities and experiences they have that don't square with who they need God to be. The Holy Trinity is one of those teachings that is best encountered rather than dissected. It is only through being present with the Trinity that we can experience both the immensity and otherness of God's presence as well as the intimacy of the God who wants us to call Him "dad." We feel the loving guidance of a God who wants to take us from fear and give us confidence. Our God of yesterday, today, and tomorrow is a God of all ages whose three-fold Presence invades all senses, seasons, and times. God, who is Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, is much more than any of our expectations if we simply let God be who God is.


