



## WELCOME TO HOLY ROSARY PARISH

#### Dear Friends,

Here is some information recently made available to us from the Diocese of Evansville. Holy Rosary will be hosting a *listening session* on **Monday**, **January 24th** at **6:30pm** in the **school cafeteria** for the English speaking community. Likewise, there will be a *listening session* for the Spanish speaking community on Wednesday, February 2nd at **6:30pm** in the school cafeteria.



- What is a synod? A synod is a meeting or a gathering of bishops. In 2023, there will be a Synod of Bishops in Rome on the subject of synodality (or "journeying together"). In preparation for that Synod is a diocesan phase and a national phase. What we are doing between now and June 2022 is the diocesan phase.
- What happens during the diocesan phase? During this phase, we'll be hosting listening sessions and sending surveys to get a sense of how people journey together in the Church, that is, how they walk with other people and how they are helped (or not helped) by the Church. These listening sessions are focused on the experience of our people, not on ideas or abstract concepts.
- What happens with the information from the listening sessions? From our listening sessions, we will develop a synthesis that will go to the USCCB (United States Conference of Catholic Bishops), which will synthesize all the contributions from dioceses across the U.S. The Vatican will then take all the contributions from across the world and use them to create a preparatory document for the Synod of Bishops in 2023.
- Does this mean we have to wait until 2023 to do something? No, it certainly does not. We are asking for the guidance of the Holy Spirit to help us take the next step forward. If there are major themes that emerge from these listening sessions, then we will follow the Spirit's lead and pray for the guidance to respond. We are really depending on the guidance of the Holy Spirit for this process.
- How can I participate? You can attend one of the listening sessions, which are currently being scheduled throughout the diocese. If you are unable to attend a listening session, there will also be an online survey you can use to offer your experience of journeying together. The survey will not be available until February 21, 2022, as we want to encourage as many people as possible to attend the listening sessions.

#### Queridos amigos,

Esta es una información que nos ha facilitado recientemente la Diócesis de Evansville acerca del proceso del sínodo propuesto por el Papa Francisco. Holy Rosary ofrecerá una sesión el **lunes 24 de enero** a las 6:30pm en la cafetería de la escuela para la comunidad en inglés. Asimismo, habrá una sesión en español el miércoles 2 de febrero a las 6:30pm en la cafetería de la escuela.

- ¿Qué es un sínodo? Un sínodo es una reunión o una reunión de obispos. En 2023 habrá un Sínodo de los obispos en Roma sobre el tema de la *sinodalidad* (o "viajar juntos"). En preparación para ese Sínodo, hay una fase diocesana y una fase nacional. Lo que estamos haciendo desde ahora hasta junio de 2022 es la fase diocesana.
- ¿Qué sucede durante la fase diocesana? Durante esta fase, organizaremos sesiones de escucha y enviaremos encuestas para tener una idea de cómo las personas viajan juntas en la Iglesia, es decir, cómo caminan con otras personas y cómo la Iglesia les ayuda (o no). Estas sesiones de escucha se centran en la experiencia de nuestra gente, no en ideas o conceptos abstractos.
- ¿Qué pasa con la información de las sesiones de escucha? A partir de nuestras sesiones de escucha, desarrollaremos una síntesis que irá a la USCCB (Conferencia de Obispos Católicos de los Estados Unidos), que resumirá todas las contribuciones de las diócesis de los Estados Unidos. El Vaticano luego tomará todas las contribuciones de todo el mundo y las utilizará para crear un documento preparatorio para el Sínodo de los Obispos en 2023.
- ¿Significa esto que tenemos que esperar hasta 2023 para hacer algo? No, ciertamente no es así. Estamos pidiendo la guía del Espíritu Santo para que nos ayude a dar el siguiente paso hacia adelante. Si hay temas importantes que surgen de estas sesiones de escucha, seguiremos la guía del Espíritu y oraremos para que la guía responda. Realmente dependemos de la guía del Espíritu Santo para este proceso.
- ¿Cómo puedo participar? Puede asistir a una de las sesiones de escucha, que se están programando actualmente en toda la diócesis. Si no puede asistir a una sesión de escucha, también habrá una encuesta en línea que puede utilizar para ofrecer su experiencia de viajar juntos. La encuesta no estará disponible hasta el 21 de febrero de 2022, ya que queremos animar a la mayor cantidad de personas posible a asistir a las sesiones de escucha.

- clothing (11 families)



# STEWARDSHIP


#### STEWARDSHIP OF GOD'S GIFTS IN THE NEW YEAR

Nothing is more important than cultivating a closer, deeper relationship with God. Make a new commitment to a time each day to listen to God's voice.

- Stewardship of Family: How often in our busy lives does time with family get short shrift? Resolve to find a special time with each family member each week. Make sure that family meals are celebrated frequently. Plan a special family outing once or twice a month, and go to Mass together. Resolve that when your spouse and child speak, you will look at them and truly listen.
- Stewardship of Health: Your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit. Without good health, we lack the energy to serve the Lord well. Resolve to make that doctor or dentist appointment. Make one healthy change in your eating habits. Add a few minutes of extra exercise to each day's routine.
- Stewardship of Possessions: Want less. Live more simply. Do you own your possessions, or do they own you? Challenge yourself to sacrifice something you like but that you know another person needs more than you.
- Stewardship of the Parish Family: Offer your service to the liturgy or a ministry of your parish in the New Year. Enrich your parish and your parish experience by becoming involved.
- Stewardship of Money: Take charge of your budget and your checkbook. Reprioritize your financial goals to ensure that the Lord is coming first in the expenditure of your wealth. Plan your spending and don't spend reactively or impulsively.
- Stewardship of Work: Do your best at your chosen profession. Be honest and faithful. Resolve to find a class or other forum that will strengthen your knowledge and expertise. Bring a prayerful attitude to your job.
- Stewardship of Mind: Resolve to read something regularly that enhances your faith life. Resolve to learn more about your faith and especially Catholic social teaching.
- Stewardship of Neighbor: Be aware of those around you, whether it be your co-workers, fellow parishioners, neighbors, restaurant workers or store employees. Everyone needs a smile and Christian kindness.
- Stewardship of the Poor: Resolve to interact with the poor in some specific way this year. Resolve to choose a time and place to minister to the poor in some way. Bring them into your prayer life as well.


