



WELCOME TO HOLY ROSARY PARISH


Dear Friends,

What should the letter say?

- Address the letter to: "[Name of Youth], and the members of the Saint Maria Goretti Youth Distinction Selection Committee;" forward to Carol Ann Gaddis
- Please state the relationship of the adult to the youth, and how long the adult has known the youth
- Then, write in the body of the letter stating how the youth lives these ideals: Leadership, Service, Commitment to their Faith, Membership in the Parish Faith Community and personal qualities that mark him or her as a Catholic
- State why the Youth is seen as a leader


