WELCOME TO HOLY ROSARY PARISH

Dear Friends,

This past October, Pope Francis announced a two-year global consultation process in anticipation of a 2023 synod on synodality. In his view, “A synodal Church is a Church which listens” and he emphasized that mutual listening has been the goal of much of the church’s renewal since Vatican II. In a time when many in the church lament what they perceive as a top down model of church, Pope Francis is seeking to honor the Spirit working in the lives of the faithful and create a process that gives them a voice as we as church take a look inside, seeking to identify our strengths and our struggles. To this end, dioceses around the world are gathering input at the local level from parishioners. In general, parishioners will have the opportunity to share what their experience of church has been, how they feel about those experiences, good or bad, and what have been the blessings experienced in the life of the Church. This feedback will be collated, summarized and made available to the USCCB and will impact their contribution to the XVI Ordinary General Assembly of the Synod of Bishops, dedicated to the theme “For a Synodal Church: Communion, Participation, and Mission,” at the Vatican in October 2023.

En octubre pasado, el Papa Francisco anunció un proceso de consulta global de dos años en previsión de un sínodo de 2023 sobre la sinodalidad. En su opinión, “Una Iglesia sinodal es una Iglesia que escucha” y enfatizó que la escucha mutua ha sido el objetivo de gran parte de la renovación de la iglesia desde el Concilio Vaticano II. En un momento en que muchos en la iglesia lamentan lo que perciben como un modelo de iglesia de arriba hacia abajo, el Papa Francisco busca honrar el Espíritu que obra en la vida de los fieles y crear un proceso que les dé una voz a medida que nosotros, como iglesia, tomamos una decisión. Mirar hacia adentro, buscando identificar nuestras fortalezas y nuestras luchas. Con este fin, las diócesis de todo el mundo están recopilando información a nivel local de los feligreses. En general, los feligreses tendrán la oportunidad de compartir cuál ha sido su experiencia de la iglesia, cómo se sienten acerca de esas experiencias, buenas o malas, y cuáles han sido las bendiciones experimentadas en la vida de la iglesia. Estos comentarios serán cotejados, resumidos y puestos a disposición de la USCCB e impactarán su contribución a la XVI Asamblea General Ordinaria del Sínodo de los Obispos, dedicada al tema “Por una Iglesia Sinodal: Comunión, Participación y Misión”, en el Vaticano en octubre de 2023.

- Then, write in the body of the letter stating how the youth lives these ideals: Leadership, Service, Commitment to their Faith, Membership in the Parish Faith Community and personal qualities that mark him or her as a Catholic
- State why the Youth is seen as a leader
- Sign your name, state your position & phone number.

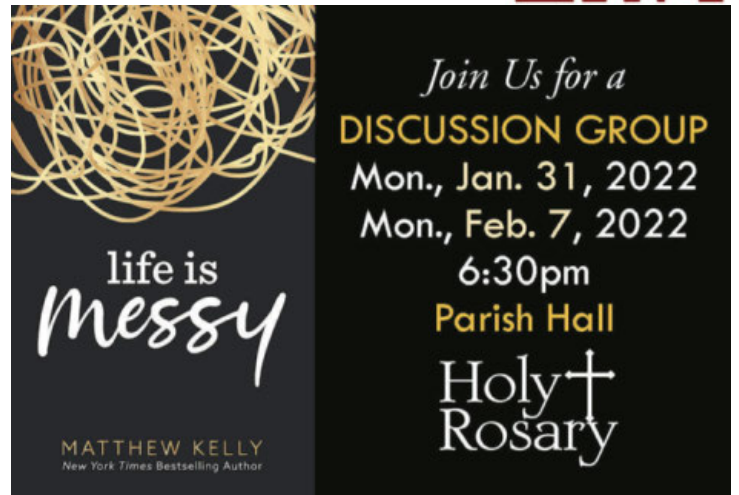
Our focus is listening to you. We want to know how you've been helped or not helped by the Church over the last few years and how you've experienced God through it all.

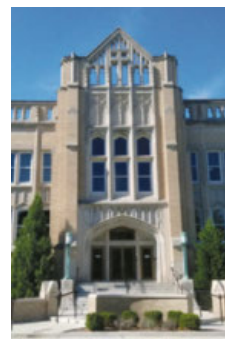
