Deacon Brett's Discourse

Eschatology, studied within theology, is concerned with the *eschaton*, the final end. We often simplify by describing our sense of the "end times." It would be truer to the Catholic approach to speak of the fullness of time, the way God will have all things ultimately be.

The Catholic perspective on God's ultimate resolution for all things is Christianity's most optimistic approach to that finality. Imagery in the Book of Daniel, the Gospel of Mark – and later in the Book of the Revelation – are all part of an apocalyptic mindset influencing Jewish thinking, especially between 100 BC and 100 AD. It was a mindset that reacted to historic oppression, relied on God's decisive intervention, and believed in an ultimate justice. The apocalyptic mindset was about giving people hope that they could say to their oppressors, "Do your worst! Our God will be our triumph!"

The way that we should be thinking "apocalypse now" is in leaving those things in our lives which are enemy to Jesus Christ at his feet and be consecrated according to his one sacrifice. In that, we – through and as the Church – will more perfectly be that generation that endures until the fullness of time.
