Deacon Brett's Discourse

For the Baptism of the Lord the phrase that comes to mind is, "They grow up so fast, don't they?" Liturgically, we've moved ahead about 30 years in 16 days. In revealing and celebrating only what is necessary for salvation, God knows to cut to the chase and the Church focuses us on those essentials without inflicting spiritual whiplash.

In Luke's account of Jesus' Baptism we are again hearing an excerpt of what was just proclaimed on the Third Sunday of Advent. We can faithfully hold the connections in expectation and joy – the joy of that expectation not being for John the Baptist, but for Jesus in being the one mightier than John. According to Luke, the Holy Spirit descends like a dove bodily upon Jesus while the Father's voice is both intimate and implicitly external. We can hold on to the hope of seeing and hearing the fulfillment of salvation.

We faithfully and hopefully hold these emphases because in the "rush" to get here, we have already received the example of the Holy Family, and particularly Mary as the Mother of God. We can hold these essentials in our hearts and reflect on them in love.

COVID-19 Parish Guidelines

There is a growing concern in our medical communities that the Delta variant could begin to overwhelm local healthcare facilities, as it is in other parts of the state, country and world. Due to the strong recommendation of the healthcare community, which includes consultation with the local community:

There is an expectation that all unvaccinated be masked at all indoor parish functions including the Celebration of the Mass. We would also strongly encourage all vaccinated parishioners to mask at this time, because there is growing evidence that vaccinated transmissions can still take place. We continue to strongly recommend that everyone mask indoors and to please postpone unnecessary meetings. Large gatherings that include a meal are also being discouraged for the time being. Everyone dispensing the Eucharist should be masked and Eucharistic Ministers should sanitize their hands after receiving the Eucharist.
