Deacon Brett's Discourse

Isaigh lived some 700 years before Peter and Paul. Peter was part of the inner circle of Jesus' ministry. Paul encountered the Risen Christ by direct revelation. Yet, they each recognized that they were flawed in ways that could have derailed their relationship and service to God. Isaiah, Peter and Paul were still all open to the gift of divine grace which super-abundantly provided them with the strength to be what God ultimately created them to be.

It's important to remember that the acceptance of grace doesn't mean there's less of a free choice to make. Isaiah, Peter and Paul never lived perfectly, they were human. God understood and embraced their humanity – as He does ours. It's rightly said that saints are sinners who keep trying.

Grace can come by encounters, but the faith that grace inspires has to be lived by choices. Two spiritual adages offer direction for making that work. First, in every choice do the next right thing. Secondly, God qualifies the called, rather than calling the qualified. Let's answer Jesus' call to go deep into our faith – grateful that God understands we aren't angels or demons, but the human people he lovingly created.


COVID-19 Parish Guidelines


