Deacon Brett's Discourse

Over time, expressions which had been part of daily conversation become part of the past. It's likely that the phrase, "... for good measure" has slipped away like that. Giving someone good measure is better than doing justice for them. Justice is giving someone their due, no more and no less. Giving good measure is a way of saying, "Here, take what is due, plus something over and above that, in order to know that you have been dealt with well."

Our readings help us to process that goodness is better. In a desert place, David spares Saul's life – and his water supply. All people face the earthly life of Adam – and by the grace of the life, death, and Resurrection of Jesus – all people have the hope of heavenly life beyond the stark justice of an earthly death. The Gospel passage calls us to challenging responsibilities – and ability to fulfill them: we are empowered to forgive; to bless; to help; and ultimately to love.

In fact, we are so empowered that we can do all that good for others – even enemies – as we would do it for ourselves. That's a thought to consider for good measure.

COVID-19 Parish Guidelines

There is an expectation that all unvaccinated be masked at all indoor parish functions including the Celebration of the Mass. We would also strongly encourage all vaccinated parishioners to mask at this time, because there is growing evidence that vaccinated transmissions can still take place. Everyone dispensing the Eucharist should be masked and Eucharistic Ministers should sanitize their hands after receiving the Eucharist.
