



Deacon Brett's Discourse

As King David's chosen capital, Jerusalem was the focus of reviving the national identity of Israel. As the site of the Temple, it was the place for Jewish sacrificial worship. The Gospels, especially the Gospel of Luke, make the connection between Jesus' Passion and Jerusalem.

Luke 9:51 is a turning point, "When the days for his being taken up were fulfilled, he resolutely determined to journey to Jerusalem,..." A closer translation of the original Greek turns "resolutely determined" into "set his face" – which alludes to Isaiah 50:7. So begins Luke's "Travel Narrative," presenting Jesus' last journey to Jerusalem in an adaptation of the Greek "hero journey" framework. Organized into chapters, this structure accounts for nearly ten chapters in Luke's Gospel. Two points are inescapable. First, Jesus' ultimate journey to Jerusalem was essential to who he was. Second, he intently wanted to make that journey.

It's important to remember that Jesus focused his will on that last entry into Jerusalem because it was the Father's will, and the Son embraced it freely. Holy Week gives us the opportunity to be "... standing within your gates, O Jerusalem." May we stand there with Jesus, and for the same reason.
