Deacon Brett's Discourse

During the Easter season, we hear of the Church at these stages out of the order in which they happen. However, it's a better arrangement for our continued connection with the crucified and Risen Jesus.

In the Acts of the Apostles, they are bold, confirmed by the Holy Spirit in the power, rightness, and fulfillment of Jesus' Resurrection. Peter leads them in witnessing. Our connection with them is in times when bold faith is treated as dishonorably. Revelation looks at the Church from the view of God's ultimate justice. We know that whatever we endure to live our participation in Christ hopefully leads to our participation in his glory. Jesus as encountered in the Resurrection appearance at the Sea of Tiberias (Galilee) takes the initiative to offer the graced opportunity to reconnect. The Apostles reconnect to the first great catch of fish, to the feeding of thousands with a few loaves and fish, and to the love of God through Jesus that they must continue to make real in people's lives.

That opportunity is handed over to us now, in and as the Church. May we reconnect to Jesus to persevere even through dishonor into glory.

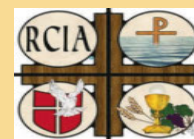

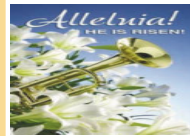

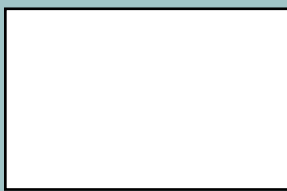
