

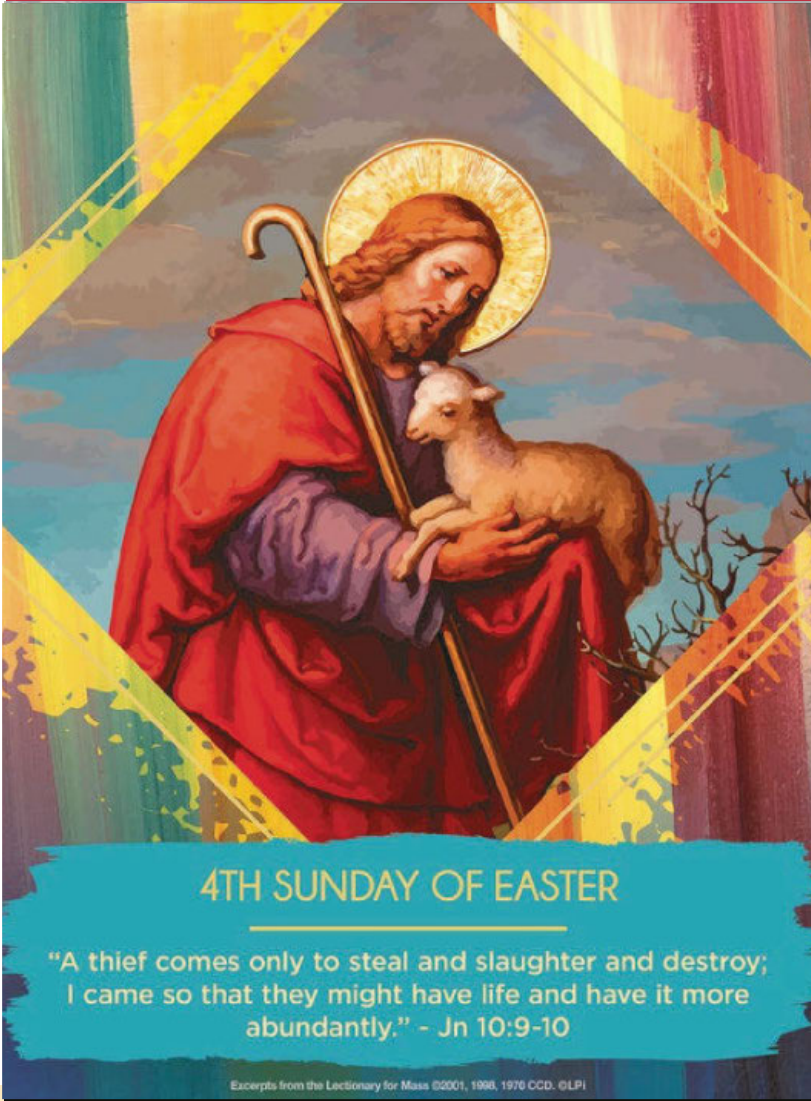

Deacon Brett's Discourse

In John's Gospel Jesus is depicted as intensely direct in His message. John's Jesus in the image of the Good Shepherd is no exception. The difference in tone provides a pause in perspective as the Church celebrates and prays for vocations.

A vocation is a call. Consider vocations in three aspects. Every call is at least from someone, every call is at least for someone, and every call is at least toward something. The Church teaches that a universal call from God for human beings is toward the happiness of eternal life. Likewise, God universally calls people to a redeemed and living holiness. God ultimately then calls us each specifically to the individual life He respectively created each of us for – and any interest the states of life that the Church reveres as particular vocations deserve the fair and prayerful consideration of discernment.

Jesus is indeed the Good Shepherd and we are indeed the flock that should listen only to His voice. Jesus shepherds as the Gate, and we follow-through by the Gate. Any calls that come from or direct toward other than the Gate can only rob us of the abundant life God intends for us.

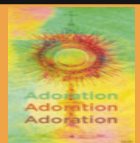
