

Deacon Brett's Discourse

The ongoing exploration of Acts during the Easter Season brings us to the New Testament genesis of deacons – men ordered by the laying on of hands to the assistance of the Apostles. Today, deacons continue to succeeded those original seven in an ordered ministry of service (diakonia).

The order of the diaconate (deacons), as an office of the clergy, underlies the higher orders of the presbyterate (priests) and the episcopacy (Bishops). The priesthood of priests rests upon always being a deacon first. The same is true for Bishops – always first a deacon, and then a priest. Clergy are ordained to be specific visible signs of service for the Church. A convenient but unsubtle classification is that deacons are signs of the service itself, priests are signs of the Paschal Sacrifice's service of redeeming forgiveness, and Bishops are signs of the Apostolic Succession's service of authoritative guidance.

All members of the Church can and should embody the general diakonia of serving the corporal and spiritual needs of others. By making room for that in our lives, we can better embrace the sure and certain hope that God finds room in us, and we in Him, for life eternal.
