

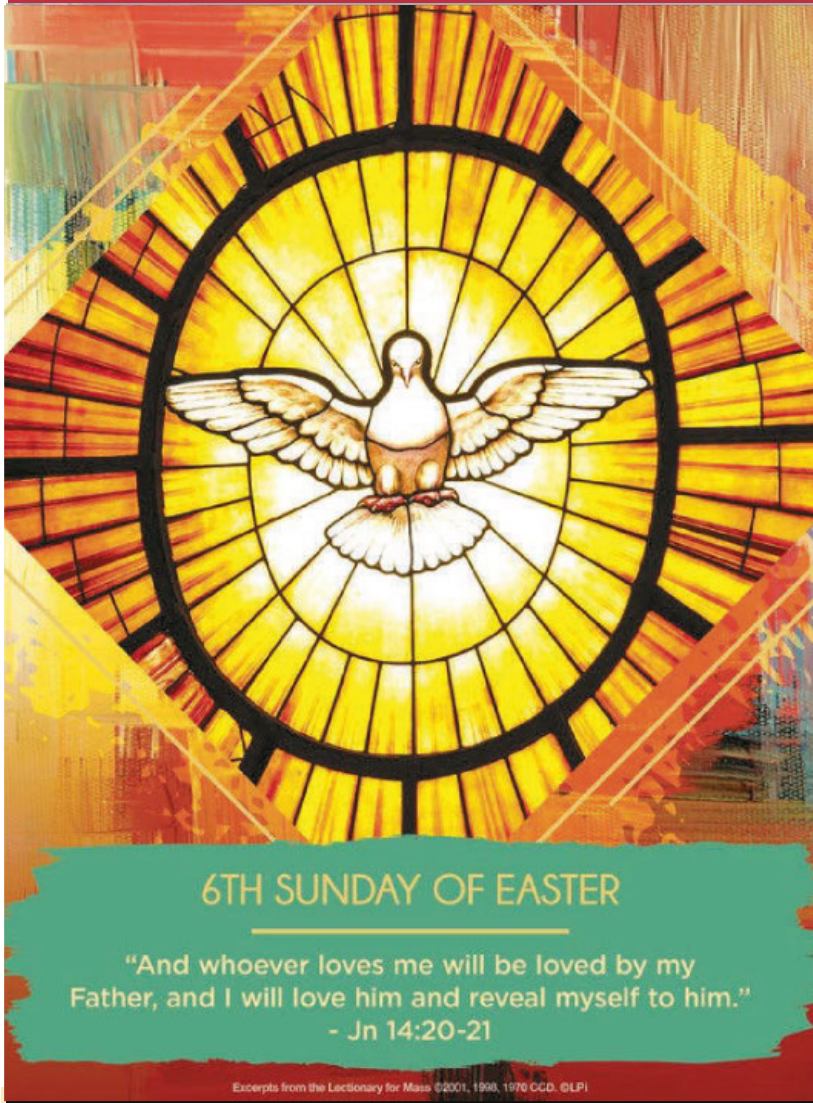

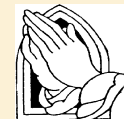

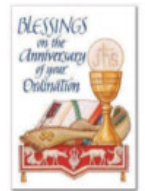

Deacon Brett's Discourse

Moving closer and closer to Pentecost after Easter, the receiving of the Holy Spirit is clearly a key theme to appreciate from the Catholic perspective.

Acts reports that the Samaritans had “only been baptized,” the Holy Spirit, “had not fallen on any of them yet,” and the reading explicitly ends by observing they received the Holy Spirit when Peter and John laid hands on them. Importantly, Acts is NOT SAYING the Samaritans ONLY received the Holy Spirit when confirmed by the Apostles. Even in their “only baptized” stage, the Samaritans were experiencing spiritual peace, joy, healing, and deliverance from evil – dynamics works of the Holy Spirit. The answer to the question of receiving the Holy Spirit either at Baptism or Confirmation is BOTH/ AND. In Baptism, we are claimed and bear the seal of that claim. God freely exercises that claim spiritually to reveal and foster relationship with us. In Confirmation, we are fully spiritually empowered, and called to bear the additional seal that imprints our more active commission.

Ultimately, what Acts IS revealing is that BOTH Baptism AND Confirmation are necessary and proper to the fullness of receiving the Holy Spirit. Hopefully, this explanation was gentle enough.

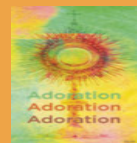
